Dear brothers and sisters in Christ.



You probably are all familiar with John 3:16 ("for God so loved the world..."), but are you familiar with Revelation 3:16? It states, "...because you are lukewarm, neither hot Pastor's desk nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth."

Am I a lukewarm Catholic - Christian? Am I fulfilling my baptismal responsibilities in the life of our parishes? There are and will be plenty of opportunities to grow in your Catholic faith this upcoming year, but I also encourage you to take personal responsibility on learning some aspect of our faith you might be struggling in. For example, why should I go to confession? FORMED.ORG has a great resource on understanding this wonderful sacrament (https://watch.formed.org/forgiven).

Beginning Tuesday, August 13th, I will be hosting at OLPH hall a series called Catholicism 101, which you will bring your questions or topics to discuss from 6:00 – 8:00 pm and we'll conclude with the rosary at 7:30. I will get the evening started with some basics so as not to overwhelm you. These sessions will be held once a month (a calendar will be coming out soon). On **Thursday**, August 29th, there will be a welcome dinner @ 6:00 pm in the OLPH hall for all those interested in wanting to dive deeper into our Catholic - Christian faith. These gatherings will be held weekly for those wanting to become Catholic at the Easter Vigil or for anyone desiring to know more about our Catholic faith. We will also continue the Bible study on Tuesday mornings in the OLPH hall from 9:00 – 10:30 am beginning **Tuesday**, **September 3rd.** These gatherings will include a study of the Mass, Mary, Who Am I to Judge, and a series on the Real Presence for the Fall semester. In the Spring, we will watch a series from FORMED.ORG called Symbolon to help us better understand and articulate our faith. TMIY (That Man Is You) will also resume in September as well, which will take place on Fridays during the academic year (more details to follow).

Our youth Faith Formation will resume as well. Please reflect on how the Lord is calling you to carry out your baptismal responsibility by either signing up as a catechist (one who echoes down), purchasing snacks/water for the youth, helping with sign-ups at registration time, or your financial gifts to help off-set the cost for the summer youth camps/conferences.

The Lord calls each one of us to be magnanimous in our own unique vocation, but HE never calls us to mediocrity or to be lukewarm. Cultivate and develop your prayer life as a family, especially praying the ROSARY daily or at least praying a decade.

May God bless and protect each one of you and avoid spiritual mediocrity/lukewarmness.
