BIBLICAL THEME (AUG 1, 2025 - JUL 31, 2026): JEREMIAH 17:7-8



Dear sons and daughters of God the Father,

JEREMIAH 17:7-8

"Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, whose trust is the Lord. He is like a tree planted by water, that sends out its roots by the stream, and does not fear when heat comes, for its leaves remain green, and is not anxious in the year of drought, for it does not cease to bear fruit."

This is our theme for our parishes starting August 1, 2025 and ending July 31, 2026, in which we will choose a new theme at that time. What steps do you need to take to trust more in the ways of the Lord, which sometimes can be very difficult? What steps are you taking to remain close to living waters? Is your life bearing good and holy fruit?

Bearing an abundance of good and holy fruit requires each one of us to be sacramentally connected to the life of Jesus Christ via the sacrament of confession and receiving the Eucharist in a state of grace. A life of prayer is extremely essential to learning to trust in the Lord and bearing an abundance of holy and good fruit. Strive for sainthood!
