FROM THE PASTOR

Dear sons and daughters at OLPH/SJA,

I pray you all are doing well. As you know, I am on a Marian Pilgrimage visiting Our Lady of Lourdes in France and Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal. Our Lady appeared to Bernadette Soubirous, a young and poor teen living in southern France, in 1858. The Blessed Mother appeared to Bernadette and announced she is the Immaculate Conception. This dogma had been announced by Pope Pius IX just four years earlier. Bernadette was uneducated and had very little knowledge of a higher Catholic education. She was a humble and docile servant of Jesus who suffered physically, mentally, and spiritually.

I will also be visiting Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal. Our Lady appeared to three poor, teen peasants in 1917. She revealed some very powerful messages to these three children, which are now canonized saints in our Catholic faith. I would encourage and invite you all to study more about this particular approved apparition.

There is only one Mary who has appeared to different cultures in different times to convey some heavenly message, which always must be discerned by the local and universal Church.

Please know of my prayers during this pilgrimage for each one of you so our parishes continue to produce an abundance of holy and good fruit. I look forward to sharing these graces with you all when I return. God bless you and your families.
