



> Telling of the gift that God gave us that day, Christmas is a celebration of Jesus' Birthday.


Then she turns on the music for the Whiffley's to sing, And passes out drums and bells for all to ring.

She says here's a song for us all to sing, A song all about our Savior The Newborn King.


"The Drummer Boy", music sheets she has in her hand, Saying we should all sing along and the song will be grand.





