BABY NAMING

- 1- Abhishekam (purification of baby and mother)
- 2- Mekhala bandhanam (applying red thread around baby's waist)
- 3- Madhu prashanam (feeding Honey) or a fruit juice
- 4- Surya darshanam(first time looking at the Sun)
- 5- Bhoomi sparsh (first time baby touches on Earth)
- 6- Naam ghoshana (formal announcement of Name)
- 7- Lok darshnam (opportunity of blessing by everyone)

HAVAN **On the Havan Vedi**

- 1-lighting of the fire
- 2-Brahman varan
- 3-Kund poojanam
- 4-Havan for all devi & devatas
- 5-Main havan (may be Gayatry havan with special mantra)
- 6- ARATI & SHANTI PRAYER

Yajman should face East and purohit should face (Priest) North or either direction.

According to our SANATAN DHARAM pooja vidhi, Mrs Yajman should remain right side of Mr Yajman during poojan and havan.
