# SCORE CDC HAS MORE

SCORE CDC has several initiatives and programs we provide to implement civic engagement activities in the South City community at the grassroots level.

## South City Community Empowerment Initiative

The South City Empowerment initiative is headed by a resident-led planning team and other stakeholders with a desire to connect residents to opportunities that provide the tools, information, and skills needed to empower themselves as well as develop community infrastructure and build resident capacity. This is accomplished through a series of activities that include:

- Informational and idea generating workshops
- Neighborhood improvement and community service projects
- Community gatherings that promote the positive aspects of South City
- The development of the “collective resident voice” to empower, strengthen, and invigorate the neighborhood spirit
- Nurture community pride



## South City Resident Leadership Academy

South City Resident Leadership Academy is a three-month training initiative that provides actively involved residents with the information, skills, and resources required to become informed decision-makers. The participants are referred to as Neighborhood Navigators and are often called upon to serve as critical and informed advocates for South City. Participants will attend various workshops to help them better lead and assist SCORE CDC with important tasks. The workshops include:

- Understanding Data
- Project Development & Execution
- Funding Projects

## Other SCORE CDC Activities

SCORE CDC hosts several other initiatives and activities throughout the year to help impart a sense of community, cohesiveness, economic equity, and fun in South City. They are designed to:

- Create fun activities for families and youth
- Identify community assets, and leverage them to strengthen South City
- Mobilize and activate community assets and resources
- Neighborhood beautification (clean-up and murals)
- Engage the South City faith-based community
- Engage public officials to ensure they are advocating for the needs of South City
