# Polar Bear C2C Afghan



This pattern is based on a graph which I found on this website. I've added rows, changed colors and done a ridiculous border which makes it my own. The pattern is to replicate what I've done. I will attach the grid, but if you're vi/blind, you may struggle with it.

### **Difficulty: Intermediate**

Crochet Hook: F 3.75 mm

Yarn: Super soft yarn

Gauge: 6 rows – 10cm

Finished Size: 120cm x 180cm

#### Materials:


- (A) 300g (720m) Light Aqua
- (B) 300g (720m) Dark Aqua
- (C) 300g (720m) White
- (D) 100g (240m) Lilac
- (E) 150g (360m) Light Grey
- (F) 50g (120m) Black

#### Note:

You will not break the yarn when changing colors unless otherwise noted. Try to keep your colors ordered so that they don't get tangled. You might have 2 of the same color balls joined on the same section because it's more efficient.

Follow graph for color changes. I used (A) and (B) for the background color. White, grey and black are the same as in the pattern. I used lilac instead of red.

When you drop a color and go to the next: yo, through stitch, yo, pull through 2 loops, yo with new color, pull through last 2 loops, tighten previous color by pulling dropped yarn.



## Beginning/Increase:

Row 1: With (B) Ch 6, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 chs (1 block)

Row 2: Ch 6, turn dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook and in next 2 chs. Sl st into ch 3 space. Ch 3, 3 dc in same ch-3 space. (2 blocks)

Row 3: Ch 6 turn, dc in 4th ch from hook and in next 2 chs. \*Sl st into ch 3 space. Ch 3, 3 dc in same ch 3 space. Repeat from \* across (3 blocks)

Row 4 – 25: Repeat row 3

Row 26: Join (A) and tie off (B). Repeat row 3.

Row 27-39: background stays as (A)

Row 40: Join (B) and tie off (A)

Row 41-50: background stays (B)

Row 51: Decrease here: Turn. Sl st into each dc of last block made, \*Sl st into ch-3 space. Ch 3, 3 dc in same ch-3 space. Repeat from \* across. (each row will have 1 less block than the previous)

Row 52-56: background stays (B)

Row 57: Join (A) and tie off (B) Repeat row 51

Row 58-84: Background stays (A)

Row 85: Join (B) and tie off (A) repeat row 51

Row 86-113: Background stays (B) repeat row 51 until end, join (E) for edging Edging:



Row 1: ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in next 2 dc, \*dc around to corner, ch 3. Repeat from \* to last corner, ch 1 dc into starting ch3. (hook should be in middle of what looks like ch 3)

Row 2: ch 3, dc in first dc, \*ch 5, sk 5 dc, dc in next dc. Repeat \* to corner, dc in last dc in row, ch 3, dc in first dc around corner, Repeat \* to next corner. Repeat corner process to end. Tie off

Row 3: Join (C), ch 3, 3 dc in next ch 5 space, \*ch 1, 4 dc in next ch 5 space, continue to corner, 3dc-1ch-3dc in corner. Repeat \* to end. Tie off, join (E)

Row 4: Ch 3, dc in first ch1 space, ch 5, dc in ch 1 space, continue to corner, 3dc-2ch-3dc in ch2 space of corner. Repeat \*to end. Ch 3 turn

Row 5: Dc in last dc from corner dc, \*ch 5 dc in next dc, continue around to corner, 3dc-2ch-3dc in ch2 space of corner. Repeat \*to end. Tie off, join (C), ch 3, turn.

Row 6: Repeat row 3. Tie off, join (E), ch 3, turn.

Row 7: Repeat Row 4. Ch 2, turn.

Row 8: Sc around. Tie off, weave in.
