Complete User Guide — All Features & How to Use Them

Welcome to E2

E2 — Everything Equestrian is a complete horse-management app designed to live on your phone. It runs entirely in your browser (or as a native mobile app), saving your data locally and optionally syncing it to the cloud when you're signed in. Below is a plain-English walkthrough of every tab, panel, and option in the app.

The app is divided into six main tabs at the bottom of the screen:

	Home Your daily command centre — weather, agenda, safety, timer, finances, and barn overview.
	Barn Full management for all your horses and other animals.
	Map Find nearby equestrian services and plan trail rides.
	Hub Marketplace listings, virtual tack room, and community feed.
	Shows Browse, enter, and prep for equestrian competitions.
	Guide Equestrian encyclopedia, health reference, and show-prep checklist.

Tab 1 — Home

The Home tab is your daily dashboard. Everything you need before, during, and after a ride is here.

Live Weather Widget

The weather card at the top of the Home tab shows current conditions for your location automatically.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Now / Hourly / 5-Day	Tap the three buttons to switch between current conditions, an hourly forecast, and a 5-day forecast.
Temperature	Displays in °F (imperial) or °C (metric) depending on your Region settings.
Wind & Humidity	Shown in the stat row beneath the main temperature.
UV Index	Shows UV level so you can plan outdoor rides safely.

Today's Agenda

A smart to-do list that automatically surfaces things that need your attention today — overdue care tasks for your horses, upcoming show deadlines, and budget alerts. Tap any agenda item to jump directly to the relevant section of the app.

Smart Calendar

A horizontal 7-day calendar strip shows the current week. Days with events have a gold dot beneath them. Tap any day to see what's scheduled.

Barn Overview

A quick summary of all your horses — their status badge and any overdue care tasks — displayed as a compact table. Tap any row to open the full Barn tab for that horse.

Rider Safety Panel



One of the most important features in E2. Keep this panel active whenever you ride solo.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Activate / Pause	The panel is on by default. Tap the ▼ arrow to expand it, or the Pause button to disable it temporarily.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Emergency Contacts	Add your family members, trainer, and equine vet phone numbers. Tap + Add Emergency Contact. These are real numbers — the app will actually call/text them.
SOS Button	Red SOS button sends an SMS with your GPS coordinates to ALL your contacts at once. Works from the collapsed panel header too.
Fall Detection (toggle)	When on, the app monitors for sudden impacts. Toggle on/off inside the expanded panel.
Live GPS Sharing (toggle)	Shares your real-time location with contacts while you ride.
Auto SOS — 60 s (toggle)	Automatically sends SOS if you trigger it and do not cancel within 60 seconds.
Estimated Return Time	Tap the 'Est. Return' box and type a time (e.g. 4:30 PM). Contacts can see when you're expected back.
Battery Indicator	Shows your device battery level in the panel header so you know if you have enough charge before a long ride.

Dual-Mode Timer

A ride timer built right into the Home tab.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
 Stopwatch mode	Counts up from zero. Hit Start to begin, Stop to pause, Reset to clear.
 Countdown mode	Set a target time (hours, minutes, seconds). The bar shrinks as time runs out. Turns red in the last 10 seconds and plays an alarm when it expires.
Log Ride shortcut	After finishing a ride, tap Log Ride to jump straight to the Training Journal in the Barn tab and record the session.

Finances — Budget Tracker

Track your monthly equestrian spending from the Home tab.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Set Monthly Budget	Tap the pencil icon next to the budget amount and type your total monthly budget. Hit Save.
Add Expense	Tap + Add Expense, fill in the amount, category, and optional note, then save. The bar updates immediately.
Progress Bar	Blue bar fills as you spend. Turns gold when you're near the limit, red when over.
Quick Add from Today's Agenda	If a budget alert appears in the agenda, tap it to jump straight here.

Tab 2 — Barn

The Barn tab is the heart of E2. Every horse (and other animal) you own lives here, with a full management panel each.

Adding a Horse

- Tap the + button at the top right of the My Horses section.
- Fill in the name (required), breed, date of birth, height, weight, and coat colour.
- Optionally tap the photo area to upload a photo from your device.
- Tap Add Horse. The horse appears alphabetically in the list.

Horse Profile Card

Tap a horse's name row to expand its full profile. Inside you'll find the following collapsible panels — tap any panel header to open or close it.

Training Journal

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Log Tab	Chronological list of all ride sessions. Tap any entry to expand it and see full notes, duration, and mood.
Calendar Tab	Monthly calendar view — dots show which days had sessions. Tap a date to see that day's entry.
Stats Tab	Bar charts showing discipline breakdown for March, session mood distribution, and an activity heatmap.
Add Entry	Tap + Log Session. Fill in date, discipline (dressage, trail, etc.), duration, mood emoji, and free-text notes. Save.

Budget & Expenses

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Set Budget	Enter a monthly budget for this specific horse.
Add Expense	Log farrier visits, vet bills, feed costs, supplements — any expense. Assign a category for reporting.
Progress Bar	Visual spend vs. budget tracker, colour-coded green → gold → red.

Daily Care Checklist

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Care Tasks	Pre-built list of daily tasks: feed AM, feed PM, water check, stall clean, turnout, grooming, hoof pick, blanket check. Check each off as you do it.
Overdue Badge	The red badge on the horse row header shows how many tasks are overdue for today.
Mark Care (Home shortcut)	The 'Mark Care' button on the Home tab jumps straight to this panel.

Diet & Nutrition

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Feed Entries	Log each feed product: hay, grain, supplements. Record daily amounts.
AI Feed Advisor	Type a health keyword (e.g. 'laminitis', 'senior', 'underweight') and the app shows curated product recommendations with Amazon links.

Medications

Track ongoing medications, dosage, frequency, start and end dates, and prescribing vet. Useful for compliance logs and insurance claims.

Vet Records

Log vet visits with date, reason, findings, and follow-up notes. Attach a photo of paperwork if needed.

Weight Log

Record weight measurements over time. The chart shows trends so you can spot unhealthy gain or loss quickly.

Farrier Log

Log each farrier visit: date, type of service (trim, shoe, reset), notes, and cost. Set a reminder for the next visit interval.

Documents & Certs

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Add Certificate	Log Coggins/EIA tests, health certificates, breed papers, or any other document. Enter certificate type, number, issue date, and expiry date.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Expiry Status	Colour-coded: blue (more than 30 days), gold (under 30 days), red (expired or within 7 days).

Feed Cost Calculator

Enter each feed item: bag weight, bag price, and daily amount fed. The app calculates your daily, monthly, and yearly feed cost automatically. Add multiple items for a total running cost.

Insurance

Store your policy number, insurer name, contact details, and annual premium. Set a renewal reminder so you never let coverage lapse.

Injury & Lameness Timeline

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Log Injury	Record date, location on body, cause, severity (1–5 scale), description, and expected return-to-work date.
Check-Ins	After logging an injury, add daily check-in notes to track recovery progress.
Resolve	Tap 'Mark Resolved' when the horse returns to full work.
Active Injuries	The panel header shows a count of currently unresolved injuries.


Boarding & Facility

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Facility Details	Record stable name, contact name, phone number, board type (full/partial/pasture), and monthly cost.
Payment Log	Log each board payment: date, amount, and note. Keeps a running history.

Trainer Lessons & Goals

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Log Lesson	Record date, trainer name, lesson focus, trainer feedback, homework for next session, and a star rating (1–5).
Goal Tracker	Open goals extracted from lesson notes are displayed at the top of the panel so you always remember what you're working toward.

Sharing a Horse Profile

Tap the  Share button on any horse card. A shareable summary card is generated that you can copy and send to a vet, trainer, or new owner.

Other Animals

Below the horses section is an Other Animals section. This works the same way — add dogs, cats, donkeys, goats, or any other animal. Each gets its own profile with a care checklist, vet records, weight log, and AI-powered feed recommendations tailored to that species.

Tab 3 — Map

The Map tab helps you find equestrian services near you and plan trail rides.

Directory — Find Nearby Services

The top of the Map tab shows a category filter bar. Tap any category to search for those businesses near your location.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
All	Shows all equestrian-related places.
Equine Vet	Large-animal and equine-specialist vets.
Regular Vet	General animal hospitals.
Farrier	Horse shoeing and hoof-care specialists.
Boarding	Boarding stables and equestrian facilities.
Feed & Tack	Feed stores and tack shops.
Venues	Show grounds and equestrian arenas.

Each result shows name, distance from you, rating, and address. Tap a result to see full details, then tap Directions to open Google Maps, or Call to dial directly from the app.

Note: Live search results require a Google Places API key to be configured. In demo mode the app shows sample data.

Trail Rides — Ride Tracker

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Start a Ride	Tap the trail ride panel and tap Start Riding. GPS tracking begins, and a live timer counts your ride duration.
Save a Ride	When you finish, tap Stop and then Save. Give the ride a name. It's added to your saved rides list.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Saved Rides	Browse past rides with date, duration, trail name, and horse used.
Leave a Review	Tap any saved ride or venue and tap Leave Review to rate and describe the trail.

Tab 4 — Hub

The Hub brings together a local marketplace, a virtual tack room, and a community board.

Marketplace

Real-world listings of horses, tack, and gear for sale near Omaha, NE (sourced from DreamHorse.com and EquineNow.com). The app shows price, condition, location, and a link to contact the seller.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Category Filter	Tap All / Horses / Tack / Gear to narrow results.
Photo Upload	Tap the photo box on any listing to attach your own image if you're managing the listing.
Contact Seller	Tap a listing card to open the original source page and contact the seller directly.

Virtual Tack Room

A digital inventory of your tack and equipment. Add items with name, condition, brand, purchase date, and value. Useful for insurance documentation and loan tracking. Each item has a photo upload slot.

Community

A local community board showing posts from nearby riders. Add photos and notes to share ride reports, ask questions, or post lost-and-found notices.

Tab 5 — Shows

The Shows tab manages your competition calendar — from finding events to logging results.

Browsing Shows

Feature	What it does / How to use it
My Entries	Shows you've already entered. Shows days-until countdown for upcoming events.
Nearby Scope	Toggle between My Entries, Regional, and Nearby to change the event radius.
Discipline Filter	Filter shows by discipline: Dressage, Hunter/Jumper, Western, Eventing, Barrel Racing, Endurance, Polo, Reining, and more.

Show Detail Modal

Tap any show card to open its full detail modal with four inner tabs:

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Info Tab	Full show details: date, location, prize money, organiser contact, and entry status. Tap Enter Show to register.
Prep Checklist Tab	A discipline-specific prep checklist (paperwork, grooming, equipment, travel). Check items off as you complete them.
Weather Tab	Live weather forecast for the show location on the show date — so you can plan your outfit and horse care.
Share/Social Tab	Invite friends to the show or post about your entry on social media directly from the app.

Logging Results

After a show, open the show card and tap Log Result. Enter your placing, score, any comments, and the date. Results are saved to your record permanently.

Tab 6 — Guide

The Guide tab is an equestrian reference library built into the app — no internet required for most of it.

Knowledge Hub

A searchable index of equestrian topics. Use the search bar at the top to find any term instantly.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Health & Conditions	100+ horse health conditions organised by category: Emergencies, Respiratory, Digestive, Musculoskeletal, Hoof Health, Skin & Coat, Neurological, Preventive Care, and Vital Signs. Each entry includes signs, causes, and what to do. Urgent conditions (call vet immediately) are highlighted in red.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Disciplines	Descriptions of all major equestrian disciplines — dressage, eventing, barrel racing, polo, endurance, western, hunter/jumper, and more.
Glossary	Definitions of equestrian terms, from 'aids' to 'withers'.
Vital Signs Reference	Normal heart rate, respiratory rate, temperature, gut sounds, mucous membrane colour, and hydration check — all in one card for quick barn-side reference.

Show Prep Checklist

A standalone printable checklist you can customise for your next competition. Select your discipline at the top and the list adjusts accordingly. Check items off in the app or share it with a helper.

Membership

Upgrade to Standard or Pro membership for additional features. Tap the Membership section to see plan details and subscribe.

Settings & Account

Region & Units

Tap the  globe icon in the app header to open Region & Units settings.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Country	Select your country. This changes the health certificate name (e.g. Coggins in the US, Passport in the UK) and other region-specific terms.
Currency	Choose your currency (USD, GBP, EUR, AUD, CAD, and more). All financial fields in the app update immediately.
Units	Imperial (lbs, miles, °F) or Metric (kg, km, °C). Affects weight, height, weather, and distance displays throughout the app.

Account & Cloud Sync

Tap the user icon in the header to open the account panel.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Sign Up	Create a free account with email and password. Your data is then backed up to the cloud.

Feature	What it does / How to use it
Sign In	Log in on any device to restore your horses, journal, show entries, and settings.
Sign Out	Clears the session. Local data on the device is preserved; cloud sync pauses until you sign back in.
Cloud Sync	When signed in, horses, other animals, and key records sync automatically to Supabase cloud storage in the background.








Onboarding (First Launch)

On first launch the app walks you through a three-step setup: enter your name, add your first horse (name, breed, colour), then you're ready to go. You can skip and add horses manually later.

Sponsor Bar

A thin banner below the app header shows rotating sponsor messages relevant to the tab you're on (e.g. feed products on the Barn tab, saddle brands on the Hub tab). Tap the banner to visit the sponsor. Tap the dots to manually cycle through sponsors. This is how E2 stays free.

Quick-Start Tips

-  **First thing:** Add your horse(s) in the Barn tab — everything else in the app uses your horse list.
-  **Before every solo ride:** Open Home, expand the Safety panel, and confirm your emergency contacts are set.
-  **Finding a vet:** Go to the Map tab, tap Equine Vet, and grant location permission for live results.
-  **Show coming up:** Use Shows tab → Prep Checklist to make sure nothing is forgotten.
-  **Outside the US:** Tap the globe icon first to set your country and currency so the app speaks your language.
-  **Multiple devices:** Sign up for a free account so your data syncs between your phone and tablet.
-  **During a lesson:** Use the Home tab Countdown Timer set to your lesson length so you pace each exercise.
