### Our Students from Zambia


This school year we want to highlight some of the countries that our students come from. This month we are featuring our four students from Zambia, two pastoral students and two deaconesses.

Zambia is a landlocked country in southern-central Africa, with a population of over 20-million. While Christianity is its official religion, in reality many people continue to practice African traditional religions, or they mix it with their "Christianity." Solid teaching is needed.

Common challenges faced throughout Africa are the influence of Pentecostalism on the one hand and liberal church bodies and mission groups of the other hand, which twist the Gospel. While the LCMS is not in altar-pulpit fellowship with The Lutheran Evangelical Church in Africa, they want to be faithful, confessional Lutherans in their teaching and practice. So, LCMS is sponsoring pastoral and deaconess students at Matongo so that they might learn and teach the truth. I had the joy and privilege to visit with their leadership this summer when I traveled to Zambia to evaluate one of their deaconesses on her internship. It is always encouraging to meet with fellow Christians who want to know and cling to the truth of the Gospel. Please pray for our students and their church.
