Before May 31, applicants will submit **a single pdf document** to ***tobermoryhsa@gmail.com*** containing the following.

- A. Name, phone number, email, and address of primary (home) residence.
- B. Proof of Canadian citizenship or Permanent Resident status in Canada.
- C. Proof of residency in Northern Bruce Peninsula, e.g., a driver's license.
- D. Academic grades (transcript or report card) for the current and previous year.
- E. Name of the health care profession chosen from the table; and proof of acceptance into a college or university program leading to certification in that profession.
- F. A description, using no more than 500 words, of how your experiences have motivated and prepared you for your chosen health care profession.
- G. A description, using no more than 500 words, of your plans to practice your chosen health care profession to the benefit of the residents of Northern Bruce Peninsula.
- H. The names and email addresses of two referees that have agreed to send letters of reference to us by the deadline. If a referee has given their letter directly to you, please include it with the application. We suggest that one of the letters be from someone that can speak to your academic qualifications and/or experiences.

***Applications will be evaluated out of 100 with 35% for the transcripts, 20% for the reference letters, 30% for the response to item F (experience) and 15% for the response to the item G (Practice in NBP).***

***All applicants will be notified of the results by June 14.***
