--- Mark Your Calendars for May 7, 2019 ---


In reference to the Waterway Park Native Plant Trail, the St. James Garden Club webpage says this about native plants:

"Since so many of our residents are from outside the coastal area, identification of these plants would be very helpful in understanding our ecosystem and also serve as examples of plants that they may be able to incorporate into their landscaping. Using natives in a community setting helps restore the character of the land and places fewer demands on resources. They provide food and shelter for native wildlife and help to sustain native butterflies, beneficial insects, birds, mammals, reptiles, and other native species."
