
2020 St. James Native Pond Plant Sale Starts Today!

For the second year in a row the POA Ponds Committee is having a plant sale focusing on native wetland plants and shrubs suitable for pond banks. There are 9 perennials and 4 shrubs available for sale through Lumber River Native Plants. These native plants are natural buffers for pond bank erosion and protection from harmful chemicals in fertilizers. Many of our sale plants attract butterflies, hummingbirds, and pollinators. Water quality, pond health and beautification – that is what this plant sale is all about.

Mouse over the "2020 Native Pond Plant Sale" to see the 13 plant species. Click on one to get complete information about that plant from either the NC State Extension or the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture (USDA.) You will also see "Where to Plant" information for each species. Mouse over one of the plant species and click on the "Feedback." You will see comments from residents who purchased it last year and responded to our plant sale survey later in the year. There is a "Questions & Comments" section carried over from last year. There is also the "2020 Order Form." You will need to print this out to order your plants.
