

St. James Pond Buffer Zone Plant Sale

Plants by Lumber River Native Plants

- Eleven (11) native perennials from shallow water to low land wet zone area – 4” pots: \$3.00 each
- Three (3) pond bank shrubs – 1-gallon pots: \$7.00 each
- Order forms available here and online.
- Fill out order form, turn in to POA office with check made out to Lumber River Native Plants (no credit card orders) by May 6 (two weeks +)
- Plants will be delivered on Saturday, June 11th, at the Community Center parking lot. Pickup between 10:00 – Noon.



Southern Blue Flag Iris (*Iris virginica*)

- Shallow or muddy zone (wet roots)
- Perennial
- Height: 1 – 2 ft.
- Can be in standing water year round



Soft Rush (*Juncus effusus*)

- Shallow water or muddy zone
- Perennial
- Height: 1 – 2 feet
- Deep root system provides good shoreline protection
- Thrives in direct sunlight
- Inundation, but not for long periods



Arrow Arum (*Peltandra virginica*)

- Shallow water plant
- Perennial
- Height: 1 – 2 feet
- Good wave-buffering protection
- Provides cover for waterfowl, wading birds, and insects



Pickerelweed (*Pontederia cordata*)

- Shallow water plant or muddy area
- Perennial
- Height: 1 – 3 feet
- Attractive purple flower
- Good wave-buffering protection
- Needs protection from turtles (fence)



Seashore Mallow (*Kosteletzkya pentacarpos*)

- Moist soil or muddy area
- Moderately salt tolerant perennial
- Height: 1 – 3 feet
- Attracts hummingbirds, butterflies and other pollinators



Lizard's Tail (*Saururus cernuus*)

- Shallow water plant
- Perennial
- Height: 1 – 3 feet



Bulltongue Arrowhead (*Sagittaria lancifolia*)

- Shallow water or mud zone
- Perennial
- Height: 2 feet
- Full sun to partial shade
- Summer/fall showy white blooms



Sweet Flag (*Acorus americanus*)

- Shallow water or mud zone
- Perennial
- Height: 2 feet
- Full sun to partial shade
- Elongated green flowers



Swamp Milkweed (*Asclepias incarnata*)

- Moist soil or mud zone
- Perennial
- Height: 3 feet
- Full sun to partial shade
- Food source for Monarch caterpillars
- Flowers attract many pollinators
- Long flowering season



Swamp Sunflower (*Helianthus angustifolius*)

- Muddy zone plant – can grow on drier soils with moisture provided
- Perennial – likes full sun
- Height: to 6 feet
- Late summer to fall blooming
- Attracts songbirds and pollinators



Scarlet Rose Mallow (*Hibiscus coccineus*)

- Muddy zone plant (can tolerate some inundation)
- Perennial
- Height: 6 feet
- Attractive to hummingbirds, butterflies, other pollinators



American Beautyberry (*Callicarpa americana*)

- Shrub, deciduous
- Full sun
- Height: 3 – 6 feet, can be pruned (best in late winter)
- Fall fruit attracts songbirds
- Best pollination with multiple plants nearby



Virginia Sweetspire (*Itea virginica*)

- Shrub, deciduous
- Part sun, part shade
- Good erosion control on pond banks/slopes
- Height: 3 –4 feet
- Attracts butterflies, other insects
- Seeds eaten by songbirds



Inkberry (*Ilex glabra*)

- Shrub, evergreen
- Slow growth (5 feet in 20 years)
- White flowers, fall berries
- Attracts bees, butterflies, and birds
- Moderately salt-tolerant
