### Where do we compete?

Our indoor unit competes in a circuit, similar to a league in sports. While each circuit makes its own rules and has its own judges, they usually conform to those rules set by Winter Guard International (WGI). The circuit in which we participate is the Mississippi Indoor Association (MIA). MIA holds many competitions or "events" across the state of Mississippi. At the end of each season, MIA holds a championship, which will be the conclusion of our competitive season. This year, we will also send tapes to the Winter Guard International (WGI) circuit. This is a larger circuit with more performance opportunities. We made this decision to fill out our performance schedule and expose our group to more experienced groups.

### Who can participate?

The Hernando Indoor Winds Program is open to all Hernando students in grades 9-12 who are members in good standing of a **performing concert band**. Placement priority will go to the student's primary instrument. We will fill any additional spots with secondary instruments. Take note...All students must consider band functions a **PRIORITY. This includes attendance at band rehearsals and performances in order to attend indoor practices and events.**\*\*\*All Band Fees Must Be Paid Up to Date\*\*\*

\*\*\*A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required to participate\*\*\*

### **Attendance Policies**

Attendance at **ALL** rehearsals and performances is **MANDATORY** and is very important to every member of the group. Indoor Winds is a co-curricular activity. Please understand that an absence from this activity has a direct impact on the **ENTIRE TEAM.** 

**Emergency Absences** - These will be granted on a case-by-case basis (i.e. death in the family, etc.) In this case, please notify Mr. Killough, Mrs. Jones, or Mr. Gill IMMEDIATELY via email or phone.

**Tardiness** - Students are expected to be ready to rehearse at the assigned rehearsal time. Tardiness WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. We would like for your students to prepare for the real world, in which they will be asked to arrive for their job 10-15 minutes before their work begins.

ALL rehearsals and performances are MANDATORY - Any student who misses rehearsal, especially during the week of a performance, may or may not be allowed to perform on the upcoming week's performance. The student will still be required to attend the performance in full uniform. In the event of an EMERGENCY, if students need to miss rehearsal to accommodate a conflict, the director must be notified IMMEDIATELY. Due to the effect of a member missing a competition, this action could result in dismissal from the ensemble. Every member's role in the ensemble is crucial to our success. Unlike a sports team where substitutes are available, all of our players start all of the time. We cannot rehearse or perform successfully to the ensemble's full potential without every member present. Should attendance become an issue, the staff reserves the right to remove you from the program.

### **Audition Process**

The Hernando Indoor Winds audition is a two-day process consisting of both a visual and musical audition. On **November 15 and 16** all students auditioning will have an optional group audition workshop where we will discuss technique and visual expectations at length. **Woodwinds** will be in the gym from **4:30-6:00** on the 15th, the Brass will be in the gym from 4:30-6:00 on the 16th. The base music portion of the audition will be taken from **concert band auditions**. On **November 18-19** students will have their required auditions. The first day of auditions (November 18th) will be entirely visual and will include toe-down marching, jazz running, overall visual, and a dance portion learned during the audition. The second day of auditions (November 19th), auditionees will be asked to individually perform **Box Drill** (F8, L8, B8, R8, F8, R8, B8, L8, Stab-Halt) while playing **Harloff #3**. Students will sign up for times beforehand starting with 3:20, and have 4 minutes for their audition. Students will be scored 0-50: the first 20 points are scored from group visual auditions, the second 20 points are scored from the individual music audition, the final 10 are assessed from the marching and playing portion of individual auditions.

From these scores the staff will rank each individual student, filling spots from the top. A limited number of spots will be available for the indoor season.

### **Practice Times**

Each week, we will rehearse on **Monday**, **Tuesday**, and **Thursday** from 5:00-7:00. There will also be additional rehearsal time required throughout the season. Any additional rehearsals will be posted at least a week beforehand. A full calendar can be found with this packet as well as online at hernandobands.com. Any additional rehearsals will be announced at least one week in advance. Students will be responsible for getting **their equipment** to and from rehearsals. Unless otherwise stated all rehearsals will take place at **The Hernando Armory** (3436 McCracken Rd). We will respect and take care of our practice facility or risk losing it. This means ABSOLUTELY NO TRASH, WE WILL LEAVE EVERYTHING EXACTLY AS WE FOUND IT.

### **Behavior and Attitude**

As previously stated, in order for the ensemble to be successful, all members must be present for all rehearsals and events. Therefore, members of the program must avoid behavior and attitude issues in their classes that might affect their ability to participate. In addition, negative attitudes and inappropriate behaviors during indoor winds rehearsals and events will negatively affect the status of the entire ensemble. Should behavior and attitude become an attitude in any class, rehearsal, or event, the staff reserves the right to remove the student from the program.

### **Financial Obligations**

The cost of participation in this year's Indoor Winds group is \$425. These funds go towards many things for your student, i.e. costumes, electronics, music, competition fees, travel, and other materials. (See below for a full breakdown of how money is spent.) We strive to keep fees as low as possible to allow as many students the opportunity to participate. The price listed above is the total cost for the entire season. No other fees will be asked of the students other than a few meals on trips. There will be fundraising opportunities made available to students throughout the coming months. Participation in these fundraisers is required in order to benefit from the fundraisers. NOTICE: If Hernando Band fees are not current, any money towards Indoor Winds will first go towards paying off any outstanding fees. Payment will be due all at once OR on the payment schedule provided. We are entirely self funded by member dues, so it is extremely important that all fees are paid on time. This year we are asking that all students auditioning pay a \$100 audition fee, this will be returned if the student does not make the group. Those who do make the group will have this \$100 subtracted from their total fees of \$425.

- -\$100 Audition Fee Due November 8th
- -\$100 First Payment Due November 29th
- -\$125 Second Payment Due January 3rd
- -\$100 Third Payment Due February 1st

Any student who might have difficulty paying these fees on time will be taken on a case-by-case basis and should contact Mr. Killough, Mrs. Jones or Mr. Gill immediately.
