## Youth Safari Date: May 29th Paper & 3D Targets

Event: The 2021 Wapiti Youth Safari is a one-day safari-style shoot focused on youths 17 years of age or younger\*. The shoot will be scored and awards will be given.

Adult shooters will be permitted to shoot for fun, especially if they are accompanying youth shooters, but may not compete for awards or prizes.

Format: One-day, Safari-style (combination of paper and 3-D targets) youth shoot. Each group of shooters should be accompanied by at least one adult mentor (parent or other volunteer) who will be responsible for safety, scoring shots, etc. Practice range open at 8 AM, mentors meeting at 9 AM, shooters meeting at 9:30 AM with shotgun start at 10AM.

Registration: 8 AM - 9 AM Date: May 29, 2021

Entry Fee: \$10.00 for youths; \$10.00 for adults accompanying youths or \$15.00 for adults without accompanying youths

Theme: North American Safari – all shooting will be at north American animal targets, either paper or

Number of targets: 28 (using existing field course trails).

Scoring: Safari-style, two arrows per target, known yardages

Age Classes: Peewee (age 7 or younger), Cub (ages 8 - 11) and Youth (ages 12 - 17)

Equipment Classes: (1) Free style, (2) bow w/ fixed-pin sights and/or release, (3) bare bow (no sights, fingers only)

Awards: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place medallions will be awarded.
