

HESPERIA DAYS PARADE
ENTRY INFORMATION – KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE
DO NOT RETURN WITH YOUR ENTRY

PARADE INFORMATION

Parade starts promptly at 9:00 a.m.

- Parade check-in for general entries shall begin at 7:00 a.m. on the corner of Main Street and Peach Avenue in Hesperia.
- Parade check-in for Equestrian Units begins at 7:30 a.m. at Timberlane Park, 9480 Timberlane Avenue – 3 blocks north of Main Street and Timberlane.
- Staging areas are located in residential areas - there must be NO LOUD NOISES before 8:00 a.m. The 1.2-mile parade route starts at Timberlane and Main Street.
- Parade route heads west along Main Street to 'E' Avenue, turning right on 'E' Avenue to disband.

GENERAL RULES

All participants must be uniformed, costumed, or appropriately attired. Vehicles must be **decorated and may not reach a height of more than 13' 6"**. Lettering should be at least six inches tall for readability. Forward motion of the parade **MUST** be consistently maintained. **Motorized entries are limited to 5 MPH along parade route and must stay in the 3 center lanes of parade route.** Entry performances shall be limited to one minute in duration. Elected officials are welcome to ride as a dignitary.

- If an entrant is less than 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must sign the application.
- **Entrants agree to not throw, distribute, or spray anything along the parade route.**
- **Entries expressing political or social views are strictly prohibited and will be denied parade entry. No space will be provided for candidates of an elected office.**

AWARDS

Equestrian entries shall be eligible for First, Second, and Third place for best equestrian entry. All other entries shall be eligible for First, Second, or Third Place. All entries will be judged by the Hesperia Days Parade committee. Winners will be announced on social media the following week.

❖ Certificates for the winners will be mailed out within two weeks to the address on the entry form.

REGISTRATION FEES FOR ENTRIES

Complete entries are due by Tuesday, September 11, 2026 @ 5:00 p.m. **-\$30 per entry, \$35.00 if you wanted to be entered into the best decorated contest.** All entries received after September 13, will be **\$35 per entry.** Entry fees(s) must be submitted along with the entry form.
