DAMYAK CHALLENGE

RULES

The DAMYAK CHALLENGE is not a race. It's an event. Do your best to complete the course in 2 hours, make a few friends, and have some fun.

The course starts at Miller Pointe where Boone Creek meets the Fox River then to the Stratton Dam and back. Keep near the west shore when you head south and the east shore when you head north.

- 1) Minimum age is 13 y/o. Under 18 y/o must have legal guardian present.
- 2) All participants must pay the entry fee and sign the legal waiver.
- 3) Life jackets must be worn.
- 4) Participants must wear the DAMYAK pin they get at registration.
- 5) Only human powered Kayaks.
- 6) Keep a safe distance from other boats.
- 7) The Fox Lake Water Agency has waived their sticker requirement for the event. Be sure to have your Department of Natural Resources sticker on your craft.
- 8) No alcohol.

Check in for the day starts at 7 am. Be sure to allow enough time to unload your kayak, check in, and get your kayak in the water and be ready to go by 8 am.
