

**Lingle Fort Laramie Conservation District**  
**Cost Share Program**  
**Cover Crop Seed**

January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024

**OBJECTIVE:**

To provide an incentive for landowners to utilize the no-till drill or broadcast seeder for conservation practices that address wind and soil erosion, soil health, and improve conservation on croplands, farmlands, and dryland pastures.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Constituents within the Lingle Fort Laramie Conservation District (LFLCD) boundaries.

**ALLOWED SEED:**

Cost-share includes seed used for cover crops, grasses, or alfalfa. Does not include annual cash crops such as corn, soybeans, rice, sunflowers, beans, sugar beet or cereal grains.

Seed purchased before January 1, 2024 will not be eligible for cost-share.

**COST-SHARE AMOUNT:**

Cost-share is only available to constituents within the LFLCD boundaries who rent a no-till drill or broadcast seeder from LFLCD.

- Cost-share amount is 50% of total cost of seed planted with the no-till drill or broadcast seeder up to a maximum of \$500.00 per calendar year per constituent.
- Seed cost-share will be paid after final payment due for use of the no-till drill or broadcast seeder is received.
- Copies of seed receipts must be submitted to LFLCD within 30 days of planting to receive cost-share.
- Calibration of the no-till drill must be performed by an employee/supervisor of the District or person/persons designated by the District.

**RESPONSIBILITY OF LANDOWNER:**

- To make arrangements to rent the no-till drill or broadcast seeder.
- To fulfill contractual obligations as written in the no-till drill or broadcast seeder rental contract.
- To have seed available at the time of no-till drill delivery to ensure correct calibration.
- To provide receipts to the District for cost-share reimbursement.
