

Preserve Pollinator Trees We Already Have








Be careful with pesticides: Read the label!

- Many fungicides kill entire bee colonies because bees feed their larvae a fermented product called bee bread. Fungicides prevent this fermentation, so a colony will decline or die.
- Yes, it's on the label.
- "Organic" insecticides imply safety, but if they are improperly applied, they kill pollinators. Bees are insects.
- Again, it's on the label.



Plant More Trees!

- Plant appropriate trees.
- Encourage neighbors, municipalities, and tree councils to plant pollinator-friendly trees.




