The new **Autumn Show & International Horse Trials** will include the long established South of England International CCI*** and CCI** Horse Trials.



HORSE TRIALS HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY

General

The Organiser of this horse trial, South Eastern Equestrian Services Limited, has the overall responsibility for the health, safety and welfare. A Safety Advisor, has been appointed also named elsewhere in the programme, to advise on all matters related to health, safety and welfare and to ensure that all the requirements of legislation are met.

Officials

The Organisers, Officials and Judges and Stewards have the responsibility for the implementation of the Safety Policy throughout this event and must ensure the Health and Safety considerations are always given Priority.

Spectators & Competitors

All reasonable and practicable steps are taken to ensure your health, safety and welfare whilst attending the event. You are requested to take note of the following

- a) You are advised to download a programme which contains a map showing the different parts of the event site(including suitable viewing locations)
- b) The programme also clearly shows the Information Point, Toilets and first aid points
- c) Please take particular note of any fencing, stringing, whistle blasts from officials, public address announcements and signage displayed.
- d) All drivers and vehicles must adhere to the highway code at the event

Contractors

Contractors working at the Horse Trials are required to observe best work practices, comply with all legislations relevant to the business and take all reasonable and practical steps to safeguard their employees and all those attending the event.

Exhibitors

All exhibitors are responsible for the safety of their own stands and the risks that they may pose to other persons within the allocated space or immediate surrounding area. This is subject to monitoring by the Safety Advisor.


Emergencies






