
BIDS MUST BE DELIVERED BY 4:00 p.m. on 11-14-2022.



BID INFORMATION

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:

- The bid shall be for a light chassis truck.
- Bid must meet minimum specifications.
- The awarded bidder will be required to sign a sales agreement in a form satisfactory to Mason County Fire District 6 before payment can occur.

PAYMENT:

Payment will be made by Mason County Fire District 6 at the time of Mason County Fire District 6 taking custody of the light chassis truck.

BID AWARD PROCESS

I. The Board of Commissioners of Mason County Fire District 6 will review all eligible bids at the Mason County Fire District 6 Commissioner's meeting room, 50 E Seattle Street Union, WA on:

- TUESDAY NOVEMBER 15, 2022, ON OR AFTER 10:00 AM
- For the following specified item: Purchase of light chassis truck

II. The Board of Commissioners shall review the bids and award the bid to the agency that it deems meets the needs of Mason County Fire District # 6.

III. The winning bidder shall be required to sign a sales agreement in a form acceptable to Mason County Fire District 6.

MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS FOR AN ELIGIBLE BID

1. Light chassis truck shall be a 1500/150, 2500/250 or 3500/350 series pickup truck.
2. Have an 8-cylinder engine.
3. Must meet or exceed the RAM Tradesman trim level.
4. Shall have four doors.
5. Have no more than 25,000 miles.
6. Must be manufactured by Chevy, GMC, Ford, RAM, Dodge.

Each bidder shall specify the maximum price for specified equipment. The state sales tax shall be shown as a separate item and calculated in the equipment total.

The bid must include any or all of the specified equipment. The vendor shall guarantee the bid price for the specified equipment for thirty days after bid opening

All bids shall include a provision for other Fire Department agencies, if inclined, to purchase the specified equipment at the winning bid price per the same terms and conditions for the duration of the contract specified.
