

Bill Gates' Views on Climate Change

Bill Gates
has been a
prominent
advocate for
addressing
climate
change
for over a decade,

emphasizing innovation, global cooperation, and pragmatic investments to achieve net-zero emissions. Through his book How to Avoid a Climate Disaster (2021) and his venture Break-

through Energy (founded in 2015), he

has invested billions in clean technolo-

gies like advanced nuclear, carbon capture, and green hydrogen. However, in late October 2025, Gates released a 17-page memo titled "Three Tough Truths About Climate" ahead of the COP30 summit in Brazil, which sparked debate by calling for a "strategic pivot" in global efforts. This shift reflects fiscal constraints, such as U.S. foreign aid cuts under the Trump administration, and prioritizes balancing climate action with immediate human welfare needs like poverty reduction and disease prevention

Core Beliefs

Gates views climate change as a "seri-

ous problem" driven by human activity, particularly greenhouse gas emissions from sectors like electricity, agriculture, manufacturing, transportation, and buildings. He argues that the world must reach zero net emissions by 2050 to limit warming to under 2°C, as outlined in UN reports. Key tenets include:

ÉInnovation Over Doom: Gates is optimistic about technological breakthroughs, rejecting what he calls the "doomsday view" that climate change will "decimate civilization" or cause "humanity& demise." He believes people can "live and thrive in most places on Earth for the foreseeable future" with proper adaptation.time.com

ÉEquity and Adaptation: Climate impacts will disproportionately harm the poor, but for most in developing countries, poverty and disease (e.g., malaria) pose greater immediate threats. He advocates simultaneous action: reducing emissions while funding health and resilience in vulnerable regions.inc.com

ÉEnergy and Growth: More energy access drives prosperity, but current options increase emissions. Gates supports expanding clean energy without hindering development, noting that policies like the U.S. Inflation Reduction Act (2022) exemplify effective steps.inc.com@BillGates

Recent Pivot (2025 Memo)

In his October 2025 memo, Gates urged reallocating resources amid budget cuts (e.g., the elimination of USAID, which provided \$8 billion annually for aid). He dismissed rigid emissions targets like the Paris Agreement's 1.5°C goal as "unrealistic" and pushed for:

ÉPrioritizing "tangible improvements in human welfare" over pure environmental metrics.

ÉIncreased focus on adaptation (e.g., resilient infrastructure) and health funding.

ÉContinued but targeted climate tech investments, like those from Breakthrough Energy.

Tomorrow Will Be Here You Have Nothing to Fear

Bill Gates has called for a "strategic pivot" in the effort against the climate crisis, writing that the world should shift away from trying to limit rising temperatures to instead focusing on efforts to prevent disease and poverty. Writing on his Gates Notes website, the billionaire Microsoft cofounder criticized what he described as a õdoomsday view of climate change.ö After decades of dire warnings, even one of the worldøs most influential voices on the subject now admits the narrative has gone too far.

Yet, this shift comes after a generation has been raised under a cloud of fear. For years, our children have been told that the planet may not survive long enough for them to grow up. From classrooms to TikTok, young people are bombarded with the message that their future is bleak and that humanity itself is on the verge of extinction. The result is a generation paralyzed by eco-anxietyô a modern form of despair dressed up as science.

A Generation in Panic

In a global survey of 10,000 young people aged 16ó25, 59% said they were very or extremely worried about climate change, and 84% were at le ast moderately worried. More than 45% said these fears negatively affected their daily lives. Another U.S. study found nearly 58% of youth were very or extremely worried. Instead of nurturing hope and stewardship, our institutions have taught despair. Children are told that their homes will flood, their air will turn toxic, and their food will run outô unless they act now.

But this õnowö usually means aligning with political movements, not practical solutions. Fear has become a powerful political weapon. When young people are convinced that only government control can save the planet, they become easy supporters of more regulations, restrictions, and taxes that promise salvation but rarely deliver results. The õclimate crisisö becomes a convenient tool to expand government reach, redistribute wealth, and restrain innovation.

Stewardship, Not Fear


True stewardship is rooted in gratitude, not guilt. It about caring for the world God made, keeping our water clean, our air pure, and our communities responsible not about punishing humanity for existing. Fear-driven policies crush innovation and burden small businesses with costs they cannot bear. Families pay more, jobs are lost, and yet the planet sees little improvement.

Hope for Tomorrow

The earth is still hereô beautiful, resilient, and sustained by the same Creator who spoke it into being. Yes, we must care for it, but we must also care for the souls of those who live on it. Our children deserve to know that their lives are not an environmental threat but a divine gift.

Tomorrow will be here. You have nothing to fear. The Lord is in control of our beginnings and our ends. The greatest thing we can do for our children is to help them know and love God, understand their purpose, and live as faithful members of His kingdom on earth.





California's Schools in Crisis: A Call to Parents of Faith

The recently released 2024–2025 performance scores for California® public schools offers a sobering snapshot of academic stagnationô and frankly, regression. According to the latest numbers, only 48.82 % of students met grade-level expectations in English/Language Arts. In Math, the figure drops further: just 37.30 % of students achieved grade-level proficiency.

To put that in context: in the 201862019 school yearô before the full disruption of the COVID pandemicô California& public school system recorded 51.10 % proficiency in English/Language Arts, and 39.73 % in Math. In other words, despite years of reform efforts, taxpayer investment, and post-pandemic recovery programs, our children are performing worse now than they were five years ago.

These numbers are more than statistical failingsí they reflect a crisis of culture and values. While state officials may frame this as a slight õimprovementö over last year, the truth is that less than half of our children are reading at grade level, and fewer than four in ten can claim math proficiency. Our Christian

communitiesô and especially parentsô must wake up to what this means for the future of our children, our families, and the very fabric of California society.

In many classrooms today, the greatest emphasis is not on foundational academics (reading, writing, arithmetic, history, science), but on social agendas, identity-based gender studies, and ideological content divorced from a biblical worldview. When the quest for excellence is replaced by relativism and the authority of parents is sidelined, no amount of funding or mandates can make up for it. The academic results mirror the deeper spiritual crisis: without grounding in truth that is anchored in Christ, education becomes hollow.

But there is hope. We believe Christian parents can lead the way in reclaiming their childrenss education by:

Reasserting their God-given role as the primary educators of their children.

Investigating alternatives such as Christian schools, homeschools, or cooperative learning models rooted in Scripture.

Engaging purposefully with local school boards, demanding accountability, transparency, and values based curricula.

Supporting organizations like Informed Parents-California that are working statewide to restore parental rights, improve academic rigor, and advance education rooted in biblical truth.

At Informed Parents-California, we urge every public school parent to consider the powerful tool offered by OPT OUT California. In cooperation with the National Center for Law &

Policy, OPT OUT California makes it possible for you to submit a legally binding notice to your school, excusing your child from certain programs, curricula, or assessments that conflict with your deeply held religious beliefs.

PJI-Center for Public Policy Opposes New Jersey Legislation Attacking Homeschooling Families



Trenton, NJ – Pacific Justice Institute – Center for Public Policy (PJI-CPP) announced its strong opposition to New Jersey Assembly Bill 5825 (A5825) as a threat to the constitutional rights of parents to direct their childrens upbringing and education. The bill, which imposes excessive state oversight on homeschooling families, mandates annual registration, curriculum submission, and independent third-party evaluations, is the most recent attack on homeschooling families across the country where states are increasingly taking up legislation to curtail options to public schools.

Of the many requirements contained in the bill, A5825 mandates that homeschool curricula must comply with the New Jersey Student Learning Standards for K-12 education set by the New Jersey Department of Education, including subjects such as comprehensive sex education and diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) initiatives, which may conflict with a family moral, religious, or philosophical beliefs. No other state in the nation requires that homeschool curriculum to align with that of the public schools and A5825 mandate would significantly threaten parental rights and religious freedoms, particularly for families using faith-based curricula.

"This bill is a direct assault on the fundamental rights of parents to educate their children according to their religious beliefs and values,ö said Brad Dacus, president and founder of Pacific Justice Institute. õMany parents choose homeschooling to incorporate faith-based teachings, avoid secular curricula that conflict with their convictions, or tailor education to their childø unique needs. A5825ø requirements would force families to conform to state standards that violate their religious freedoms.ö

Additionally, A5825 would require families to maintain and submit a portfolio of educational records, including samples of student work and an independent evaluation certifying õappropriateö progress, conducted by a õqualifiedö third party, which cannot be a parent. This annual portfolio requirement would create unnecessary administrative hurdles, especially for low-income families lacking resources to hire external evaluatorsô costs that could exceed hundreds or even thousands of dollars per child each year.

"Unfortunately, New Jersey's A5825 follows a disturbing pattern seen in across the country this year where lawmakers have targeted homeschooling families with arbitrary and burdensome regulations that erode family autonomy and personal choice,ö said Janice Lorrah, attorney and Legislative Counsel for PJI-CPP.

Stochastic Terrorism A challenge to the new Christian Revival

As if we don't have enough to be concerned about, an article appeared in Apple News concerning a Silicon Valley billionaire (no name given), with

anti-christ views, was taking on the Christian movement after Charlie Kirks death using technology. The technology proposed should have all concerned because it can be classified as

"Stochastic Terrorism."

What is stochastic terrorism? It involves a number of techniques used to psychologically program minds and most of all, limits free will. It uses repetition of visual and verbal messaging often hidden in content for subliminal exchange. Using social media, video games, and advertisements combined with artificial intelligence, it becomes especially dangerous to all who encounter it, but the main target is young people. So, how do we break this down?

Artificial intelligence (AI) is used to follow an individuals habits and trends on the Internet and interaction with social media. This data is then matched with wording and verbal messages that were used by the person being followed. Gradually the messaging uses suggestions to draw the suspect into a focus that is backed by imaged content. This content is usually subliminal and/or shown in short segments to force the

subject to think according to controlled options. Often times these option selections are made by curser or speech. Once the interaction takes hold, Al is used to further direct the subject or to plant specific suggestions that may take on certain behaviors. The Russians have perfected remote hypnosis using Al that is being adapted into social media this way. China is now adapting it as well.

It is believed that by using stochastic techniques on young people that over time society itself can be changed. Social behavior resulting on the extreme side can be anti- religious, racial chaos, suicide, violence, or groomed assassins. A persons free-will no longer exist.

Very little research on detection of stochastic content has been made and it is very hard to detect in hidden forms on the web. So, the purpose of this article is to inform parents to pay attention to what their kids are doing on the web and watch any changes in behavior. This has been structured to alter the thinking of "faith" and religious belief in young people as an alternative to the revival ignited by Charlie Kirk's death and Turning Point's message..

Let so look at the one book that does celebrate erotic love: Song of Solomon. Ito full of sensual poetry. But every line indicates itøs within marriageô and always between a man and a woman.Songs 1:2: õLet him kiss meí öSongs 4 and 7? A poetic feast of desire. The Hebrew word dodô beloved in a sexual wayô is used here.

Whenever, and I do mean whenever, dod is used outside the context of marriage between a man and a woman, like in Proverbs 7:18 (with an adulteress), it condemned. So yes, the Bible affirms eros. But only in the context of marriage. Always. Every other formô outside marriageô is condemned.Polygamy? Condemned. Adultery? Condemned.Fornication? Condemned.Same-sex eroticism? Also condemned.

Hebrews 13:4 makes it clear:öMarriage is honorable... the bed undefiled. But fornicators and adulterers God will judge.ö

No ambiguity. No cultural loopholes. (And in case you are wondering, Jesus also made sure we know that marriage is only between a man and a woman. Doubt that? See ahead.)Sex is reserved. Not erased. Not redefined. Reserved.

Paul never excuses rebellion because it feels romantic.

Jesus Didnøt Redefine Love or MarriageSome claim Jesus was all about love. True. But what did Jesus say about love and marriage?

Matthew 19:466"From the beginning, God made them male and female... the two shall become one flesh.ö

He quotes Genesis. He doubles down on male-female marriage. He doesnot offer an update.He affirms the original blueprint.So no, Jesus didnøt preach õlove is love.ö He taught õtruth is love.ö

So What Does the Bible Really Say?The Bible never says õlove is love.öIt says God is agape (1 John 4:8). through the lens of Godøs truth. This distinction is not superficialô it is the difference between life and death, clarity and confusion, truth and deception.

We are also warned about the influence of the **spirit of antichrist**ô not merely the coming Antichrist himself, but the present, corrupting influence shaping culture away from Godøs truth. Jesus warned repeatedly, "Do not be deceived." He gave this warning because deception will be the primary method by which the last days unfold.

Today, we are witnessing the very conditions Scripture describes. The world is rapidly being conditioned for a final, global deception. We are very close to the rise of the actual Antichristô a figure who will take control of humanity through lies, illusions, and the construction of a false reality. The preparation begins in the minds of those who no longer know how to discern truth.

This makes the renewing of the Christian mind not only important—but urgent.

Born Again Into Reality

For the Christian, being oborn from aboveo is not simply receiving a new doctrine. It is receiving a new capacity for reality. Through the indwelling Holy Spirit, the believer is called and empowered to see the world as God sees it. Yet this transformation does not occur automatically. Salvation is instantaneous; spiritual sanity is a process.

Paulos command is emphatic: "Be transformed by the renewing of your mind." (Romans 12:2)

This is not a suggestion. It is a survival mandate for the end-times believer.

A mind left unrenewed will interpret life through old frameworks, cultural lies, emotional distortions, and ungodly assumptions. It will remain vulnerable to deceptionô especially the kind that masquerades as compassion, progress, enlightenment, or tolerance. A Christian can be sincere yet still mentally aligned with the worldø illusions instead of Godø reality.



The New Covenant: Live and Obey

One of the most misunderstood areas of Christian growth is the relationship between obedience and identity. Christians are **not** required to work to become good people. That was the lesson of the Old Testament: *Obey and live*. Israel tried and failed, proving humanity inability to achieve righteousness through effort.

The New Covenant reverses the order. It is no longer *obey* and *live*—it is:

Live... and then obey.

Because of Christon finished work, believers begin their Christian life from a place of righteousness, not toward it. We who trust in Christ are made new by His death and resurrection. We are declared righteous by faithô not by performance, emotional consistency, or flawless behavior.

We remain righteous until we sin; and when we do, we do not fall out of our identityô we are invited back into restoration. We are permitted to repent, renounce the sin, and return to the righteousness of Christô completely **free from sin's bondage.**

We do not carry othe dead corpseo of our past strapped to our back. We *reckon* the old man dead and walk in the newness of life in Christ. This is not denialo it is **faith**. And biblical faith is more than beliefo it is:

- Understanding the truth
- Conviction in the heart
- Commitment of the will

This is the foundation for renewing the mind. Without knowing who we are in Christ, transformation becomes impossible. With it, transformation becomes inevitable.

Where Right and Wrong Truly Reside

Scripture teaches that the essence of right and wrong is located in the **human spirit**, expressed through the conscience. But the conscience can weaken or distort if the mind is shaped more by cultures narratives than Gods truth.

This is why the renewal of the mind is not merely academicô it is spiritual, emotional, moral, and practical. It reorders our thinking, purifies our perceptions, restores our identity, and aligns us with Godøs reality.

Without this renewal, believers risk living in a fractured stateô saved in spirit but mentally bound to old patterns. This is a dangerous form of instability, making Christians vulnerable to the deception saturating the last days.

The Human Will Must Rise

God provides the Spirit, the Scriptures, and the grace. But the believer must provide the will.

The mind will not renew itself.

Lies will not uproot themselves.

Truth will not apply itself.

To remain spiritually saneô especially as the spirit of antichrist intensifiesô the believer must choose renewal daily.

Standing Sane in an Insane World

As nations descend into confusion and moral chaos, the believer responsibility is to remain anchored in the unchanging reality of God truth. The world is being prepared for the ultimate deception, but the renewed mind stands firm, unmoved, and spiritually clear.

The call is simple, urgent, and profoundly relevant for this hour:

Be transformed.

Be renewed.

Live in Christ.

Walk in truth.

Be spiritually minded.

Be sane.**

In an age dominated by false realities, renewing the mind is not merely helpfulô it is the primary safeguard God has given His people as the last days approach.

For decades, well-meaning California officials have only exacerbated the homeless crisis. Now, with pressure from the Trump administration and the upcoming 2028 Olympics in L.A., politicians with the power to reform failed policies may finally be ready to listen and act.

The team at California Policy Center looks beyond noble platitudes of good intentions and analyzes real data. õHousing Firstö initiatives have proved costly and ineffective. A state audit released in April 2024 õestimated expen-

California's Homeless Crisis: Real Solutions for an Opportune Time

Lance Christensen, VP of Government Affairs & Education Policy at California Policy Center, has spent years researching legal reforms to identify solutions offering the Golden State a way out of its rampant homelessness quagmire. Mr. Christensen urges the time is now to take action.

ditures to help the homeless over just a five-year period from 2019 through 2023 at \$24 billion.ö Despite this jaw-dropping figure, tangible improvement is scarce. Multiple studies, including one from UCSF in June 2023, conclude approximately 80% of the homeless are in this dire situation for two reasons: mental illness and/or substance abuse. Housing First offers housing without preconditions, and people can choose whether to get treatment. Free housing does not magically heal a tormented mind

or eliminate an addict desire for drugs. Individuals may or may not elect to undergo treatment.

Mr. Christensen encourages people of faith in California who are tired of seeing the homeless trapped in endless suffering to advocate for the õTreatment Firstö approach. With Treatment First, individuals must participate in mental health and/or addiction treatment before or as a condition to receive housing.

õActual change begins at the local level,ö noted Lance in a recent Zoom call with community leaders. Here is a suggested plan of action to inspire lawmakers to consider the benefits of Treatment First:

- 1. Schedule an appointment with your local legislator at their district office.
- 2. Bring with you a family affected by homelessness, a member of the clergy who ministers to the unsheltered, and an expert, such as a psychiatrist or neurologist.
- 3. Present one or two policy changes that support Treatment First. See https://californiapolicycenter.org/reports/ending-homelessness/ for a comprehensive list of recommendations. Examples include expanding conservatorship laws, restoring funding for residential programs, and allocating money for crisis units and services at the county level.

Besides the public push at this critical time, intercession is equally vital. Pray for lawmakers to be receptive to Treatment First legislation and honest about the failures of Housing First. Uplift the leaders of organizations such as the ACLU and Disability Rights CA, who have previously blocked Treatment First measures in the name of civil liberties. Ask the Lord for unity so sensible bills will pass that truly help the homeless.

õOur Lord, I know that you defend the homeless and see that the poor are given justice.ö (Psalm 140:12, CEV) There has never been a better time to advocate for those suffering in the streets. 

On April 19,1775, the American Revolution began with the Battles of Lexington and Concord. Fighting the British would be no easy task. The colonists obviously would need an army.

Given the maritime prowess of the enemy, we also would need a navy. On October 13, 1775, the Continental Congress authorized the purchase of two

vessels to be armed for action against British merchantmen. This resolution created the Continental Navy and is considered to be the origin of the U.S. Navy. However, since the sixteenth century, the British understood the need to have detachments of õsea soldiersö or õnaval infantryö to sail with its armada. These õmarinesö performed various critical functions.

During battles at sea, these expert marksmen would engage exposed sailors on enemy ships. They would repel boarding parties dispatched to seize their own vessels, and would constitute the boarding parties dispatched to seize enemy ships. They provided assistance for manning the guns if necessary. Their skill with small arms made them an essential component of any landing force for combat ashore. Additionally, they provided the captain and other officers with a reliable

vessels to be armed for action against British merchantmen.
This resolution created the security force to ensure orders were carried out and that any attempt at mutiny was thwarted.

Yet even before the formal establishment of Continental Navy, colonial ships and their attached naval infantry had entered the fight for independence. On May 9, less than a month after Lexington/ Concord, soldiers from Brigadier General Benedict Arnoldøs Massachusetts militia captured a British sloop on Lake Champlain and renamed it Liberty. It was manned by colonial sailors and marines. Nine days later, on May 18, the Liberty and her crew captured a British sloop and renamed her Enterprise. The new crew for Enterprise included 18 marines.

These informal "marines" continued to support the revolutionary cause in a variety of waysô fighting the British, capturing their ships, and even protecting payroll. It soon became obvious to the Continental Congress that it was



time to turn these õmarinesö into õMarines.ö On November 10, 1775, Congress passed a resolution õThat two battalions of Marines be raisedí .ö and the United States Marine Corps was born.

Although not widely known, these Marines would not limit themselves to naval operations, but would be included in extended land campaigns as an adjunct of the Army. For example, Marines fought with General Washington at the critical battles of Trenton and Princeton. It has long been the practice of agencies of the United States government to

adopt a motto expressed in Latin. The motto of the United States Marine Corps is Semper Fidelisô Always Faithful. In part, it referred to their commitment to remain loyal to the captain in the event of mutiny. Beyond this, however, it referred to their undying commitment to their fellow Marines, their country, and their mission.

Semper Fidelis would also be a fitting motto for us Christians, for õWithout faith, it is impossible to please God.ö [Hebrews 11:6] May we always be ready to be the õfirst to fight for right and freedom, and to keep our honor clean.ö



How many people do you know who have fallen and broken bones?

Over the past few years, I have known people and read of celebrities who have suffered major injuries from a fall. My brother in-law fell down a flight of stairs. My sister tripped while shopping. And a well-known celebrity fell exiting a shower and is now paralyzed.

Falls can be a very serious event. An uncle of mine fell from a ladder while he was painting his home eaves. He was in his midsixties, a vibrant and energetic man. Yet, one misstep and he fell to the ground and hit his head. He was rushed to the emergency room by paramedics. Within a week he passed away.

Have I got your attention?

Iøm well over 60. I didnøt break any bones, or sustain any serious cuts, bruises or other injuries. I simply got up and returned to my seat. I did get an abrasion on my arm. However, I healed quickly, with no ongoing issues.

I thank God for his protection. And Iøm grateful for my lifestyle of eating well, exercising, and running.

What does your health score look like?

Ask yourself, õWhat can I do now to keep you from falling?

If I do fall ó what can I do now to help in my recovery?ö

The healthier you are, the more likely you will maintain an optimistic outlookô and you@ll have energy in your step. As a result, you'dl be more aware of your surroundings, while walking in crowded malls, museums, or the grocery store.

Maintaining a healthy body is key to your balance, energy and mental outlook. Your mental alertness will help keep you from injuring yourself from needless falls. One way to ensure a healthy body is with a healthy diet. Eating whole foods is extremely important. I like what one dietician recently said on how to go about eating whole foods, õeat whole foods, ö he said. That is, avoid eating processed foods.

Processed foods are not whole foods, he emphasized. And neither is fruit laden yogurt, or fruit juices laden with high concentration of sugars. So, eat õwhole foodsö that are not processed or that contain significant levels of sugar.

Be sure to include fresh, organic vegetables and fruit. Eliminate white bread, pasta, muffins, or sweet breakfast rolls. Be sure to stop eating candy and chocolates. Yes, say good-bye to your favorite Snicker bars and Hershey chocolate bars.

Are you a soda-pop drinker? Be sure to rid yourself of these very high sugar content drinks. Substitute your cravings for soda pops with lemon water, tea, and coffee. Itall take a few weeks to detox from the sugars, but itos well worth the effort.

Essential Vitamins

While you will get nutritional value from your organic fruits and vegetables, you may not get enough, or you may miss some nutrients and vitamins from your diet. To make sure you get the right vitamins to support brain and bone health, be sure to include the three vitamins B, C, D, and Calcium.

Christian's First Amendment Rights Violated at Mayday USA Event by City of Los Angeles - Lawsuit?

On May 31, during the Mayday USA event in Hollywood, the City of Los Angeles allegedly violated the First Amendment rights of a Christian group seeking to assemble and protest.

Mayday USA had applied for a permit to gather on Hollywood Boulevard to support parents and children and to celebrate their Christian faith through prayer, song, and baptisms. However, the City denied the permit, classifying the event not as a protest or assembly protected under the First Amendment, but instead as a concert or performance. Officials instructed the group to apply for a different permit through the Bureau of Street Services (BOSS), which handles permits for concerts and entertainment events.

The BOSS office subsequently denied the request, stating that they do not approve permits for protests or free speech activities—effectively leaving the group without a path forward. Organizers claim this is a tactic the City uses to discourage groups from exercising their constitutional rights.

Notably, the same type of permit requested by Mayday USA was approved for the LA Pride event the following week—at the same location and time—which also included community celebration and advocacy

Attorneys representing Mayday USA argue that the City's actions amount to a clear violation of their First Amendment rights. The City later suggested the group apply for

a last-minute permit, which severely restricted their activities: baptisms were prohibited, and organizers were told that extended singing or speaking would not be considered protected speech under the First Amendment.

Mayday USA is currently exploring legal action against the City of Los Angeles in response to what they view as unconstitutional restrictions and discriminatory treatment.

I told her that she and her husband are remarkable parents for making such a sacrifice. Every month, they pay \$5,500 in tuition to keep their children in the school of their choice. Since this is after-tax income, they actually need to earn \$11,000 to cover these costs.






