

Truth Always Percolates to the Top (Ultimately)

. . . the notion that America is a global nation without borders and national sovereignty is a thing of the past. Well, after several months, and then years, the falsehood of that idea brought down the Biden and Harris team and handed them a solid defeat in 2024.

The truth about the criminals and thousands of unvetted others came to the surface in the case of deaths to Americans, e.g. the loss of life at my alma mater, University of Georgia, of a precious nursing student out for a run. Athens, Georgia, once a conservative town when I was working towards my MBA, turned into a sanctuary city, and effectively welcomed a vile murderer from Venezuela. Ultimately, the responsibility for these types of tragedies lies in the hands of a president, vice president and homeland security chief.

When Biden took over in January of 2021, inflation was not a "thing". Within 10 months or more and several presidential directives to shut down or reduce our energy supply, we doubled the price of gasoline and fuel. Morality, Laws and Politics- Part 1.

"If there is no objective morality why was Hitler wrong?

If there is an objective morality, why do you get to decide what it is and not Hitler?"

This is the opening salvo in my conversation with individuals who ask me what right I have to impose my morality on them. How dare I argue that abortion is wrong or transgenderism is wrong, they ask in a huff. "You might think abortion is wrong but don't impose your morality on me."

But most of them don't have an answer to the question. It's a dilemma they can't resolve. You can rephrase this question for the younger generation as:

If there is no objective morality why is racism wrong?

If there is an objective morality, why do you get to decide what it is and not a white supremacist?

You see the moment you say something is wrong or something is right, regardless of which side of the issue you are on; we have to ask "why?" Why is abortion OK, but racism not?

For the left, that answer is: Because that's what the tribe says so, not because it makes sense. Just a few years ago, the tribe said that men pushing women out of jobs was bad, men taking women's opportunities was bad, men going into women's restrooms or being peeping toms was bad. Today it's not. Today, men saying they are women and pushing women out of sports, replacing women in Miss Universe competitions, taking women's opportunities to be to woman of the year, going into women's restrooms and watching girls in their locker rooms, suddenly all that is good. It makes no sense. Why did it change? It changed because that is what the tribe thinks *now*.

Wait, what are tribes? Well, the left works as a tribe. A group of people who want to be told what to do, how to think, what to say. They want to be like the other cool people in their tribe, so they comply.

But who decides what the new tribal belief is? Nobody knows. Some unknown influencer of the tribe decided this is what the tribe was going to believe and those who are woke just blindly follow. They don't know who made the rules, and the justifications are mindless, but they just blindly follow it. Why? Once you understand that they are into tribe think, into concession morality, into not thinking for themselves, then you understand why it is so hard to change their minds.

But what's the answer to the question.



Al has already demonstrated its ability to revolutionize industries. Amazon, for example, has used Al to save an astounding 4,500 years of developer work, while The Chosen, the popular TV series based on the life of Jesus, is now the most translated show in history, with plans to reach 600 languages through Al-assisted technology.

44 For Christian ministries, these advancements offer a glimpse into how Al could be harnessed to amplify impact and streamline operations. 77

At Biola University, this vision has led to the creation of two major initiatives: the AI Lab and the AI Studio. The AI Lab focuses on the ethical use of AI, conducting research and offering educational resources to ensure Christian organizations can adopt AI in alignment with biblical values. Meanwhile, the AI Studio provides

practical, hands-on support to help ministries and nonprofits develop Al-driven solutions that meet their specific needs. These initiatives reflect Biola's commitment to helping Christians leverage Al to further God's Kingdom.

The benefits of AI for Christian organizations are clear. AI can handle time-consuming administrative tasks such as scheduling, data processing, and content generation, freeing up staff to focus on building relationships and community. It can also be used to brainstorm innovative outreach strategies, target specific audiences more effectively, and manage donations with greater precision.

However, the adoption of Al is not without its challenges. Many within the Christian community have expressed concerns about whether Al could replace human creativity or detract from the personal nature of ministry. Biola University takes these concerns seriously, continuing to

research and explore the ethical implications of Al's role in the church. While these are valid considerations, Biola's experts believe Al can enhance, rather than diminish, our God-given abilities to serve others.

This transformation is already underway, and the opportunities it offers for Christian organizations are profound. By embracing AI, ministries can expand their reach and impact, helping more people while remaining true to their core values.

WHAT IS A LETTER TO THE EDITOR?

You feel strongly about an issue, and you want to let people know what you think. You believe you can even influence people to take some action if you speak your mind. But, you want to reach an audience larger than just your friends or your group membership. Letters to the editor can be an effective way to get the word out.

A letter to the editor is a written way of talking to a newspaper, magazine, or other regularly printed publication. Letters to the editor are generally found in the first section of the newspaper, or towards the beginning of a magazine, or in the editorial page. They can take a position for or against an issue, or simply inform, or both. They can convince readers by using emotions, or facts, or emotions and facts combined. Letters

to the editor are usually short and tight, rarely longer than 300 words.

Using a few carefully placed letters, you can generate plenty of community discussion. You can also keep an issue going by preventing it from disappearing from the public eye. You can stimulate the interest of the news media and create more coverage for the matters you're working on. You can also send a "good news" letter to bring recognition to people who deserve it or acknowledge the success of an effort.

WHY SHOULD YOU WRITE A LETTER TO THE EDITOR?

Letters to the editor are among the most widely read features in any newspaper or magazine. They allow you to reach a large audience. You can probably think of many more specific reasons why you might want to write to the editor, but here are a few general ones:



- ■You are angry about something, and want others to know it.
- ■You think that an issue is so important that you have to speak out
- Part of your group's strategy is to persuade others to take a specific action.

Or you want to:

- ■Suggest an idea to others
- ■Influence public opinion
- ■Educate the general public on a specific matter
- Influence policy-makers or elected officials directly or indirectly

■ Publicize the work of your group and attract volunteers or program participants

WHEN SHOULD YOU WRITE A LETTER TO THE EDITOR?

Letters to the editor can be written any time you want to shape public opinion, tell others how you feel about people, programs, or ideas, or just inform the public on a certain issue. They are a great way to increase awareness of the issues that you or your organization are working for, as well as to advocate for your cause.

The Holidays and Seniors: A Time for Reflection and Joy

The holiday season is a special time for people of all ages, but it holds unique significance for seniors. It is a season filled with opportunities to reflect on cherished memories, connect with loved ones, and celebrate traditions that have shaped their lives. However, the holidays can also bring challenges, making it essential to ensure that seniors feel supported, valued, and included during this time.

The holiday season represents time with family, football and eating a lot of food! For the senior population, this can be a scary or lonely time, even when surrounded by family, especially if facing memory impairment conditions like Alzheimer's or other forms of dementia.

When a loved one with dementia is experiencing the holidays, it's important for us to "enter their world" and try to understand what they are feeling and going through. Here are some issues to consider when including your loved one during this season, along with some solutions that can help:

■ **Disruption of Routine** – Gathering together during the holidays involves big changes in routing, which can be

disorienting, and be extremely stressful for seniors, especially those living with dementia. The sensory overload can lead to confusion, anxiety, agitation, or unwanted behaviors. Remember, your loved one may not be able to articulate their thoughts, so they may communicate their feelings through action. It is important to be aware of these behaviors, and not dismiss these actions as defiance or being difficult.

- Overstimulation large family gatherings can be overwhelming. There is a lot of noise, crowded gatherings and activity that is 'out of the ordinary'. Offer a quieter, less crowded alternative (while not isolating them) during family gatherings. This is a common and effective strategy to reduce sensory overload, which is often a trigger for distress. This approach is supported by caregiving guidelines and recommendations from dementia care specialists.
- **Dietary Changes** This can be particularly difficult. The holidays is a time when the family eats a lot of rich, comfort food. However, seniors with health issues may have dietary restrictions that can make preparing a holiday meal difficult. Rich or unfamiliar foods can lead to digestive problems, allergies, or bad interactions with medications. Seniors with dementia may also forget about their dietary needs or have trouble communicating them. Remember to check

with their doctor, for any special food needs.

- Social Isolation As much as overstimulation is an issue, you also want to avoid under-stimulation. Thanksgiving can give some people feelings of loneliness. If a senior has lost a loved one, or has limited social networks, they may find it difficult to be in a family gathering where there is more extended family. Try assigning a family member or close friend to stay with the senior throughout the gathering. This "buddy" will provide the social connection or engage them in simple activities that are not stressful. Encouraging a senior to do a small task to help prepare the food is helpful in providing purpose and combat any isolation.
- Memory and Cognitive Issues Seniors with dementia may have difficulty remembering family members or understand the significance of the holiday. They may also find it difficult to follow conversations. This can lead to disconnection. If a senior is having a cognitive issue, don't make them feel bad by correcting them. Enter their reality and redirect their attention. For example, if a senior says that he needs to pick up his mother (who has long since passed away) to get her to the family event, simply tell them that his mother called and said she will be coming by in a couple hours. Do not correct him and say his mother passed away years ago. This will prevent the person with dementia from experiencing that pain of loss. You will

then be able to redirect their attention to something happier in the present moment.

■ Physical Limitations - There may be physical limitations for a senior that need to be considered for a Thanksgiving gathering. As seniors age, they may face mobility issues, pay, or fatigue that makes it difficult for them to enjoy the festivities or take part in the activities. Simple things like preparing meals or sitting for long meals difficult. Adjust the environment and activities to accommodate their needs while still involving them in the celebration. You may need to use adaptive tools or assistive devices like easy-grip utensils and jar openers. Or it may be as simple as encouraging shorter, more frequent breaks from the festivities.

Above all, give your senior loved one choice. Know their needs if they like social gatherings or not, or if they can eat certain foods or not and give them options. Being mindful of these challenges and making accommodations, like maintaining routines, offering quiet spaces, providing assistance with meals, or keeping the gathering smaller and more manageable, can help seniors have a more enjoyable holiday season.



New East County Non-Profit Got New Voters to the Polls During a weekly leadership meeting in San Diego's East County City of El Cajon, three U.S. citizens and natives of Iraq decided to roll up their sleeves and get their family members and community leaders to help get as many of their friends and family voting on November 5th. Only a year and ahalf young, Empowerment One sought to galvanize what they called the 'Voter Adoption Initiative'throughout East County by uniting with local community leaders, other non-profit organizations, neighborhood businesses and as many local church leaders they could meet to help

residents register to vote for what has been called the most important election of modern history—The 2024 General Election.

The grassroots effort set out to recruit 500 adopters who would help ensure their 20 closets friendsand family members register to vote, there by aiming to reach ten thousand new voters across East County San Diego, ahead of November 5, 2024.

The initiative began in late July 2024, when Empowerment One invited several of its leading community members to unite in a concerted effort to help better educate its conservative residents on the many issues at hand and help those who needed support with registering to vote.

Vote teams went to local day care centers, bingo nights, community festivals and arranged voter registration events to help encourage community members to register to vote, while boosting its grassroots model by building a software program with a text messaging component created to helpbuild a database with follow-up applications that make sure everyone on it register to vote-andthen vote. The software application was developed in-house by two fellow community members, one of whom Is a co-founder of Empowement One. Mohammed Almousawi. A newly naturalized U.S. citizen himself and tech professional, who has his heart set on seeing his fellow Iraqi andbroader Middle East and North African community members live safe and successful lives and beable to offer that better future to their children.


Awareness building meetings also helped East County residents better understand the criticalissues facing the Chaldean/Assyrian and broader Middle Eastern communities, from the sexualization of school children and the transgender agenda creeping into kids' classrooms to unaffordable housing and skyrocketing prices of consumer goods; along with the ever-growing homelessness and drug crises negatively impacting residents and business owners.

Court Reopens Case: Firefighters Stand for Religious Rights

San Jose, CA – Firefighters working for the City of San Jose were placed on unpaid leave for over a month because they declined to be vaccinated for COVID-19 per a public health order. Due to religious convictions, these employees were not able to comply with the mandate.


The firefighters reached out to PJI for representation. A lawsuit was filed in the Santa Clara superior court where the employees claimed that unpaid and indefinite leave was an adverse employment action. The City disagreed. The trial court dismissed the case and the firefighters appealed. "This is a clear example of how municipalities disregard the religious rights of faith based individuals who solely want to be able to live by their Christian beliefs.

PJI is committed to the protection of those rights and we will not stop fighting" stated PJI Founder and President Brad Dacus. In a unanimous decision the California Court of Appeal reversed the lower court and awarded costs. "Public safety requires that all first responders be available for service. The City exercised poor judgment by keeping firefighters sidelined," said Kevin Snider of PJI who argued the case.

Article: Preferred Pronouns & Jesus

As a pastor, I get many questions. In recent days, I've gotten the question, "Are there any circumstances where Christians should use the preferred pronouns of their non-Christian loved ones or friends?"

Answer: Christians should not use one's "preferred" pronouns in any situation.

The Biblical basis for my argument is:

? Matthew 19: Jesus' positive affirmation of the gender binary.

? Exodus 20: God's command to not bear false witness against our neighbor.

Jesus & Gender

"Have you not read that he who created them from the beginning made them male and female, and said, 'Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh'"? (Matthew 19:4–5)

This is Jesus echoing and quoting from Genesis chapter 2. From the beginning, gender or sex was determined by God and is what composed the "image of God." What it means for man to be made in the image of God is to be created as male and female—Both sexes are equal and dependent upon one another but distinct in many ways.

Mankind by nature, then, is either male or female determined at birth by their sex and chromosomal makeup. In other words, there is no such thing as gender fluidity; therefore, personal pronouns, by nature, cannot be preferential. God Himself uses the pronouns "he" or "she" to refer only to those who received that particular sex at birth.

Bearing False Witness

Flowing from this, when God gives His law in Exodus 20, he commands His people not to bear false witness against their neighbor. If the second table of the law is our duty to our fellow man, and His law guides us in how we love our neighbor, it follows that it is inherently unloving to perpetuate someone else's delusion regarding their gender and inner feelings. To do so would be to bear false witness. Plus, even if you assure the person by saying, "I'll use your preferred pronouns even though I do not agree with your lifestyle," that statement would be unacceptable because to be against their lifestyle or inner feelings, they claim, is to be against them as an individual since they tether their identity to their sexual feelings.

Furthermore, In God's civil law to Israel, we see the outflow of the gender binary God set up in the creation order as it relates to cross-dressing.

"A woman shall not wear a man's garment, nor shall a man put on a woman's cloak, for whoever does these things is an abomination to the Lord your God" (Deuteronomy 22:5).

If a man wearing a woman's garment was an abomination to the Lord, It's safe to conclude that to change your pronouns to "she" when you're a "he" is equally abominable. If something like this is an abomination to the Lord, and I affirm someone in that delusion, then I perpetuate something that is bringing the wrath of God upon that person. Again, this is unloving.

A quick word about people born Intersex or Sexually Indeterminate:


We ought to be compassionate and gracious when encountering these hard situations. Nevertheless, this is a medical anomaly. The fact is, most people in our day who are asking to have their preferred pronouns used are not those who are born intersex. In a fallen world, of



course, we can expect chromosomal flaws and intersex people. At that point, it's a conversation to be had with that person with compassion and gentleness. I would say the person's life story, the guardians who raised them, and medical history (such as which sexual organs were more prominent and functional) should be considered rather than just what they "feel" they are. Our feelings can misfire.

We should not use the example of a medical anomaly to make void the Word of God or "negate objective categories of personhood."1

The days ahead are not going to be easy. I'm burdened for fellow brothers and sisters who have to deal with such difficulties, especially with immediate family members and co-workers. But to use their "preferred" pronouns would bear false witness against those we love, perpetuating a lie that they are trapped in and need to be rescued from. And worst of all, we would be untrue to our Master who only gave two options for gender. May our trust in God's truth be fruitful and cause us to give gospel hope to those trapped in their sin.



It is the holiday season again and I often ponder the question of who are we, as a nation, giving "thanks" to? Our forefathers formed this Nation based on religious principles of "God" and knew who to thank based on their faith. My "thanks," without faith, seems empty because there is no recipient.

Thanking one another helps show gratitude within family and friends, but we are a nation that was formed by many sacrifices, all so we can enjoy freedom within the boundaries of constitutional law.

This is driven home by my visit after the local Veterans' Home and trips to the Veterans' Hospital. There, I see lives impacted forever by their service for this country. Thanking them for their service doesn't seem to be enough. On Thanksgiving and Christmas Day many eat in the dining room alone, no family, no visitors except for brother veterans.

As I sat there with Dave, a veteran friend noting another vet setting at a table. Dave told me to watch him. He positioned himself and began tightly folding his paper napkin. David asked me if I knew what he was doing, I didn't. He was making a fuse for explosives. He did that at every meal. He never spoke to anyone, a soul lost to his existence.

When I think of this season, I reflect back to grammar school where we learned about the Pilgrims, the American Revolution and the Thirteen Colonies. But there is a whole history that has never been taught and that is the "Black Robe Regiment.

The first move toward American democracy was instituted by ministers.

Early settlers, who arrived in Williamsburg in 1619 included a group of ministers who helped form the first representative government, the Virginia House of Burgesses. They met in a church in Jamestown and were lead by Revs. Burke, Mease, Whitaker, Wickham and Hunt. From there, they elected representatives for the people.

Massachusetts was established as a colony in 1620 by pastor John Robinson. He had a radical departure from the role of civic leaders in that he eliminated special privileged status between the governing leadership and the governed, leading to a representative government. In 1636 they formed the first American citizens' Bill of Rights. In 1641 the Massachusetts Bay Colony established their Bill of Rights under the direction of Rev. Nathaniel Ward. In 1636 Rhode Island Colony did the same under the direction of Rev. Roger Williams with Connecticut following suit under the direction of Revs. Thomas Hooker, Samuel Sone, John Davenport and Theophilus Eason. These reveren founded Connecticut on three Biblical principles.

In 1636, the Rev. Roger Williams established the Rhode Island Colony and its representative form of government, explaining that "the sovereign, original, and foundation of civil power lies in the people."

That same year, the Rev. Thomas Hooker (along with the Revs. Samuel Stone, John Davenport, and Theophilus Eaton) founded Connecticut. They not only established an elective form of government but in a 1638 sermon based on Deuteronomy 1:13 and Exodus 18:21, the Rev. Hooker explained the three Biblical principles that had guided the plan of government in Connecticut.

These ministers led their men into battle against the British Redcoats and the British feared them naming them the "Black Robe Regiment." They spoke courageously about liberty and the rebirth of patriotism from the pulpit.

Driven by the overreach of government to shut down churches during the Covid-19 scare, along with government sponsored anti-Christian culture (Christian Nationalist classified as a terrorist group by the Southern Poverty Law Center), a new National Black Robe Regiment has formed. Its purpose is to equip and empower pastors to engage in their historical Biblical role to stand righteously and transform society through spiritual and cultural engagement.

Much of today's struggle for the heart and soul of America is due to the fact many pastors have not taking a stand from their pulpits. They have allowed wokeness and passiveness to replace America's moral culture in their churches. Attendance and finances have replaced actions from messages/sermons. The expansion of socialist/communist ideologies have set in motion a few hundred pastors taking a stand from their pulpits resulting in the "New Black Robe Regiment" to reclaim America.

Answers were no, but the cardiologist on duty (Dr. Reedy) thought it was the vegus nerve shutting down for which there are no drugs that work with the vegus nerve. The important thing was I met, and experienced, God first hand.

This experience put a whole new meaning on faith and God's gift of His son we celebrate at Christmas. For me, church denomination pettiness in differences in Biblical principles vanished because the basics became reality. To experience "Love" to an unexplainable level and intensity solidified the purpose of God's gift of His son Jesus. Yet, I fall short of living the full experience that was revealed to me.

I can only try and convey to both church goers, non-believers, and atheist to seek a relationship with God through His son Jesus Christ, the greatest gift to mankind and keep to the basics.

Remember! Social powers, government and elites celebrate Christmas as a time when merchants reap huge sales while the definition and purpose of Christmas fade into the twilight zone, materialism grasps a hold on society. These powers to be are extracting Christ from the purpose of Christmas when He was the "First Gift" to mankind that formed a time set-aside to celebrated Him.

My Thanks is to God for giving us men who sacrificed so much taking a stand against evils. We must not let evil overtake our nation founded on good Biblical principles. May the Black Robe Regiment really take hold and our Christmas celebration be a deeper spiritual experience.
