developments, it is crucial to compare ourselves with the scriptures and ask ourselves what the scripture actually says. Our primary purpose is to give glory to God and exalt the name of Jesus Christ at all costs. Sadly, even the church today has become entangled in various controversies and conspiracy theories, often teaching a watered-down gospel or deviating from it altogether. We must recognize that a lie remains a lie, regardless of how loudly or frequently it is proclaimed. The truth will always be the truth, even if it offends us.

The degree of decadence and moral decay we witness today seems to have no limits. We see major sporting events honoring individuals who degrade entire religions. Immoral actions are now celebrated, and the most honorable thing one can do is to be immoral. Society teaches our children that they can discard their birthright as male or female and choose their desired gender at a young age. However, the term "trans-female" is contradictory in its definition. To transfer from something implies that one must have been something else to begin with. AN INTERVIEW WITH PASTOR JESSE ALVAREZ



Christian NewsMagazine: Pastor Jesse Alvarez, you arrived at Valley Life Community Church in Selma, California during a challenging time for churches across the country due to the COVID pandemic. The statistics show that many people are not returning to their former congregations. Could you share your vision for this remarkable church campus and the people of Selma, California?

Pastor Jesse Alvarez: To understand my vision, it's important to recognize how God speaks to people, especially to pastors and shepherds like myself. It begins with a call from

God that resonates deep within our spirits. Initially, it may be a still, small voice that gradually grows louder and more intense.

"We often question this inner prompting and ask, "Is that you, Lord?"

Christian NewsMagazine: Can you tell us more about yourself, Pastor Jesse Alvarez, and where you come from?

Pastor Jesse Alvarez: I was born in Michoacan Mexico and immigrated to the United States in 1977 when I was nine years old. I grew up in Fresno, California, where I received my education. In 1986, I heard the Gospel of Jesus Christ and placed my trust in Him as my Lord and Savior. I come from a family of six siblings, one of whom is a police officer in Fresno, and others who are teachers residing throughout California.

Community Leaders oppose new Planned Parenthood clinic in Tulare, California.

As religious, civic, and nonprofit leaders in our community, we wish to express our opposition to the proposed establishment of a new Planned Parenthood clinic in Tulare, California.

We want to highlight this issue to the public and urge opposition to this business being established in the South Valley. One should take into account the mission statement of the City of Tulare when considering allowing an abortion clinic in the city limits which is: "To promote a quality of life making Tulare the most desirable community in which to live, learn, play, work, worship, and prosper".

Planned Parenthood Mar Monte (PPMM), the regional Planned Parenthood affiliate with clinics in northern California, central California, and the Reno area, is nearing an agreement to buy a 36,000 square-foot property in Tulare, CA. The property is currently owned by a farming and real estate investment company called the Lagomarsino Group.

Planned Parenthood and Lagomarsino Group are currently going through zoning processes with the City of Tulare. The plan is for Planned Parenthood to develop a massive, 6,000 square foot clinic on the currently vacant site.

We do not object to efforts to bring prenatal health care resources to the San Joaquin Valley, and in particular to Tulare County, which is in desperate need of healthcare resources.

But it is abortion, not prenatal care, on which Planned Parenthood is focused. Abortion is the cornerstone of their business model, with providers receiving \$400-\$700 in Medi-Cal reimbursements for each abortion, far more than they receive for prenatal care visits or their other, less controversial

services. Their commitment to abortion is also the obvious key to their philanthropic and governmental revenue streams, their very reason for existing.

In spite of their nonprofit status, Planned Parenthood clearly adapts its patient offerings based on what will make them the most money, not always on what the community needs.

Planned Parenthood's Medi Cal-heavy clinic on Fulton Street in Fresno, which offers both the abortion pill and surgical abortions, does not even offer prenatal care services—though their clinic on Shaw near Fresno State, with a wealthier patient base and more private insurance beneficiaries, does offer prenatal care.

The reason is obvious: prenatal care, particularly for Medi-Cal patients, is a financial loser. It takes up exam room space and provider time, and it reimburses poorly. One wonders whether a Tulare clinic will offer prenatal care services at all, given that its patient base will likely closely resemble that of their Fulton Street clinic.

Lastly, PPMM was one of the entities implicated by Congress as being involved in the unlawful sale of the bodies of aborted children to researchers from 2010-2015.

California and federal law prohibit the selling of aborted fetal tissue for profit. Both the House of Representatives Energy and Commerce Committee and the Senate Judiciary Committee found significant evidence of Planned Parenthood Mar Monte selling fetal tissue to Stem Express (a middle-man company that would procure tissue from abortion clinics and sell it to researchers Both committees submitted criminal referrals against Planned Parenthood Mar Monte to the FBI and Department of Justice due to its findings.

Abortion consistently correlates with higher levels of poverty, lack of education, and lack of access to healthcare resources. Women often choose abortion because they feel they have no other choices. The alleged "need" for abortion is, in fact, a need for community support for those in need. We can do better than abortion, and we should.






