Dairy Goat Show Date: SATURDAY of fair week, 9:00 am - Livestock Show Ring

The American Dairy Goat Association sanctions this show and its rules will govern. This is a doe show. All registered animals regardless of a herd book are eligible for entry. NO BUCKS will be shown. Health papers are required. The requirements are in the front of the booklet. All day of the show only animals and exhibitors must be in place between 7 am - 8 am on Saturday and will be released upon its completion. There will not be a pre-show milk out. A registration or recordation certificate for any animal six months or older is required. The registration or recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application showing the date received by the office is required for any animal less than six months of age. **NO COPIES** of the registration or recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application will be accepted by the show officials. Proof of ownership will be the name on the registration or recordation certificate or the stamped duplicate application. Entries are due the last Friday of July by 5:00 P.M.
