- The house is typically left open by the cleaning crew but the front door code is 9998. Punch in code and turn deadbolt, same to lock up when leaving.

- Check-in time is 4pm. Check-out time is 11am. This enables our housekeepers time to clean before the next guests arrive. Please remember that Trams fill quickly, especially during busy weekends and peak season, so we advise you to make departure/ return ferry reservations as soon as possible. Best way is on the BHI Ferry app available in your smartphone's app store. Or (910-457-5006). You will need to have all of your luggage at the end of the driveway when the Tram arrives.

- TRASH: Please lock the trash bin securely to keep out island critters. The small sign at the end of driveway needs flipped to “yes” in order for the trash to be picked up.
- SMOKING: “The Palms” is a smoke-free home. If you or your guests smoke inside the home, you will lose your entire security deposit. Smoking is permitted on the porches, please dispose of butts in the provided ash trays.
- Minimum primary renter age is 25
- A propane grill is located on the back deck for your convenience. Please brush/ wipe it clean it after each use. Propane exchanges can be obtained at the Maritime Market or refills at island hardware.
- The indoor fireplace is not hooked up nor operational.
- Bald Head Island has an apple and android app. It’s really cool and has a directory for everything as well as an island map, available activities, weather, and even a webcam.
- The island website is also very useful and can be found at www.baldheadisland.com.
- We have quite a bit of amenities at the house including: a high chair, stroller, gas/charcoal grill, games/ cards, full range of kitchen appliances/ utensils, and just about everything you need for a comfortable stay. Our canoe is available and located at slot G5 at the creek access. Paddles are in the garage. Additional bikes, paddle boards, etc. can be rented from the Sail shop or Coastal Urge. The cleaning crew leaves fresh TP rolls and small soaps in the baths. *As with the golf carts, any amenities are provided as a courtesy along with the home and their availability is neither guaranteed nor

contingent on the rental of the home. Any damage, loss, or misuse is the sole responsibility of the renter.

- Two golf carts are included in your rental fee *Owner is not responsible for any out of service or maintenance issues with these items and they are provided as a courtesy along with the home not contingent on the rental home pricing. Tenant is responsible for any damage, loss, or misuse of these items. Be sure to plug golf carts in anytime they're not in use! We have had a lot of instances of golf cart keys being lost or taken home by renters accidentally (they are small), please leave the keys in the cart ignition at all times. They can actually just be turned off at night during charging as they will not lose charge just because they're on as long as the lights are off. Also make sure each cart is plugged into it's proper charger as they are not interchangeable.
- Bald Head Island has a number of dining out options. The Maritime Market offers grab and go items, a wood fired pizza shop, Chinese takeout, as well as a popular Ice Cream Shoppe. The Poolside Bar at the Shoals Club is also open for lunch and early dinner. Jules and Jailhouse Provisions are other casual dining options and grabbing a pizza along with a drink is a great choice at Will o the Wisp in the harbor. For a more formal atmosphere, try the Shoals Club main dining room if you got the available temporary membership.
- The Creek Access is a popular place for crabbing. You'll need a net and some turkey necks or chicken parts (available at the market) tied to a piece of string. Drop the bait into the water and SLOWLY pull the string toward the surface when you feel the crab begin to nibble at the bait. When you can see the crab through the water, SLOWLY put the

net under the crab. We also have a canoe stored at the access.
Please inform us if you're interested in using it.

- If you chose to have the temporary Shoals Club membership pass, there is a small fitness center as well as two swimming pools and a beach access. Chairs, umbrellas and towels will be provided at the Shoals Club as well.
