On the northern side of 55 Drive Hughston Homes will be building a brand new community of new single family homes. At this time there are no plans for direct access between the new community and Houston Springs.

As far as the golf course is concerned it will be business as usual with no changes being made at this time.

Once everything has been finalized, WPPI will be dissolving.





## GOLF NEWS



### WHAT IS THE TECH GOLF LEAGUE? WHAT IS SOFI?

TGL is a new golf league launched on January 7, 2025, formed by Tiger Woods, Rory McIlroy and Mike McCarley in partnership with the PGA Tour to provide a first-of-its-kind experience that allows fans to watch teams of top golfers

compete in an up-close-and-personal fashion inside a custom-built arena. Together the trio founded TMRW Sports (pronounced “tomorrow”), a tech-focused venture aimed at ‘harnessing technology to build progressive approaches in sports, media and entertainment.’

Central to the vision of TGL (Tomorrow’s Golf League), a new indoor golf league, features six teams composed of four PGA Tour golfers taking part in fifteen 2-hour matches inside the SoFi Center, TGL’s custom-built 250,000 square foot venue in Palm Beach Gardens, Florida. The course within the SoFi Center is infused with various technologies and covers an area approximately 97 yards by 50 yards, roughly the size of a football field. Players hit from real grass tee boxes, fairway surfaces, rough and sand into a 64 x 53 foot simulation screen. The tech-infused green sits on a turntable 41 yards wide and includes jacks that change the slope to create a variety of play on every TGL hole.



The indoor golf center cost an estimated \$50 million to build on the Palm Beach State College campus. The college, per a lease, collects \$440,000 per year from TMRW Sports through 2028. That rate increases 2% in 2029 and again in 2034 until the 20-year lease expires.

Season tickets and premium seating are available at [TGLgolf.com](https://TGLgolf.com), starting at \$240. Individual match tickets can be found through the official marketplace [Ticketmaster](https://Ticketmaster.com). The 2026 season started December 28 and ends with semi-finals on March 17 and the best-of-3 finals series March 23-24.






