NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN

The HSCA Board of Directors is calling for Nominees for the 2025-2026 term of the Homeowner Representative Seat on the Board. This one-year term position will be elected by the Homeowners and announced on Thursday, September 25, 2025, at a Special Homeowners' Meeting.

Requirements for the position include:

- Must be a full-time resident of Houston Springs (not seasonal).
- Must be current on ALL HSCA, Social, and Irrigation fees.
- Must be able to serve a one-year term, October 1, 2025 September 30, 2026.

If you are interested in representing the homeowners and serving on the HSCA Board, please complete a Nomination Application form, available through the Property Manager's Office.

Nomination Applications MUST be submitted in a sealed envelope to the HSCA Property Manager, Kristy Walsh, no later than 2:00 pm on Thursday, August 28, 2025.

If you wish to nominate someone else, please get their written approval BEFORE you submit their name.

Once nominations have been received and accepted, an election ballot will be mailed to every HSCA homeowner. Further instructions will be included with the ballot.


Baked Potato


















National Grief Awareness Day August 30

Wear protective clothing.
