# NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN

The HSCA Board of Directors is calling for Nominees for the 2025-2026 term of the Homeowner Representative Seat on the Board. This one-year term position will be elected by the Homeowners and announced on Thursday, September 25, 2025, at a Special Homeowners' Meeting.

Requirements for the position include:

- Must be a full-time resident of Houston Springs (not seasonal).
- Must be current on ALL HSCA, Social, and Irrigation fees.
- Must be able to serve a one-year term, October 1, 2025 - September 30, 2026.

If you are interested in representing the homeowners and serving on the HSCA Board, please complete a Nomination Application form, available through the Property Manager's Office.

Nomination Applications **MUST** be submitted in a sealed envelope to the HSCA Property Manager, Kristy Walsh, no later than 2:00 pm on Thursday, August 28, 2025.

If you wish to nominate someone else, please get their written approval **BEFORE** you submit their name.

Once nominations have been received and accepted, an election ballot will be mailed to every HSCA homeowner. Further instructions will be included with the ballot.

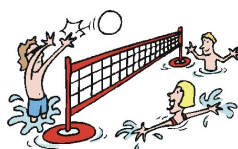

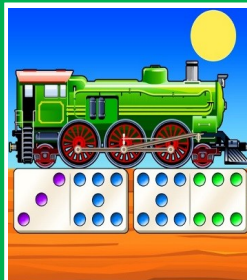

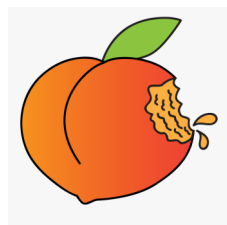

## ANNOUNCEMENTS • Hopefully the new pool furniture will have

arrived by the time you read this. There was a delay from our July 9 arrival.

- A second dog park is being considered through the Board. The Enhancement Committee will not be involved in that.
- Old Business: The pickleball court renovation has been approved & sent to the Board. \$13,000 was the final quote for resurfacing, painting, etc. WPPI will give \$6,000; we will pay \$7,000. \$2,000 was requested for new nets. Our committee proposed they raise that money or request later for that cost.
- We will not proceed with the memorial bricks as we had no email responses.
- New Business: A request was made for a bench along Spyglass Hill Road in the section between Houston Springs Blvd. & Pebble Beach Drive by the 3 shrubs. We agreed a bench could be removed from the pickleball court (they have 5) & placed there once we get Board approval.
