Lu 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.



Ex 12:3 "Speak to all the congregation of Israel, saying: 'On the tenth day of this month every man shall take for himself a lamb, according to the house of his father, a lamb for a household.

4 'And if the household is too small for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next to his house take it according to the number of the persons; according to each man's need you shall make your count for the lamb.

Ex 12:3 Hablen con toda la comunidad de Israel, y díganles que el día décimo de este mes todos ustedes tomarán un cordero por familia, uno por cada casa.

4 Si alguna familia es demasiado pequeña para comerse un cordero entero, deberá compartirlo con sus vecinos más cercanos, teniendo en cuenta el número de personas que sean y las raciones de cordero que se necesiten, según lo que cada persona haya de comer.

Ex 12:5 'Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year. You may take it from the sheep or from the goats.

(Daniel)

Da 9:24 "Seventy weeks are determined for your people and for your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, to make reconciliation for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.

Da 9:24 Setenta semanas están determinadas sobre tu pueblo y sobre tu santa ciudad, para acabar la prevaricación, y concluir el pecado, y expiar la iniquidad; y para traer la justicia de los siglos, y sellar la visión y la profecía, y ungir al Santo de los santos.

Da 9:25 "Know therefore and understand,
