MESSIAH and the Nations

1st kingdom = Babylonian

ch2 head of gold

ch 7 lion

2nd kingdom = Medes-Persians

ch2 chest/arms of silver

ch 7 lopsided bear

3rd kingdom = Grecian – Seleucids

ch2 belly/thighs of bronze

ch 7 leopard/4 wings

4th kingdom = Islam

ch2 legs/iron, feet/clay & iron

ch 7 destroying beast

attempted mixing with “seed of men” (2:43)

final kingdom - Rock crushes all previous kingdoms and establishes kingdom that will never be destroyed (2:44)

different from all the rest (7:19)

blasphemous horn (7:20)

overcomes the saints (7:21)

judged by “Ancient of Days” (7:22)

devours the whole earth (7:23)

1 of 10 horns different from the others (7:24)

rules for “*time, times, half a time*” (7:25)

divine counsel takes away his rule (7:26)

everlasting kingdom of Messiah and His saints (7:27)

Da 8-10 focus on Persia (*ram*), Greece (*goat*) and a world ruler (*little horn*) directly opposed to “Son of Man”

Da 11:1-35 *what becomes of Greece and the empire of Egypt and the Seleucids (shadow of the little horn)*

Da 11:35 *concludes 3rd kingdom – Greece (Seleucid, Roman, Byzantine)*

Da 11:36-45 *introduces the 4th and final kingdom (Ottoman)
the substance of the one against Messiah (Anti-Messiah/Christ)*

The 4th and final king of the world

Da 11:36 And the king shall do according to his will. And he shall exalt and magnify himself above every god (el) and shall speak marvelous things against the God (el) of gods (el) and shall prosper until the fury is fulfilled. For that which is decreed shall be done.

37 He will not regard the G (god) of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god. For he shall magnify himself above all.

Da 11:36 Y el rey hará á su voluntad; y se ensoberbecerá, y se engrandecerá sobre todo dios: y contra el Dios de los dioses hablará maravillas, y será prosperado, hasta que sea consumada la ira: porque hecha está determinación.

37 Y del Dios de sus padres no se cuidará, ni del amor de las mujeres: ni se cuidará de dios alguno, porque sobre todo se engrandecerá.

*2Th 2:3 Let not anyone deceive you by any means.
For that Day shall not come
unless there first comes a falling away,
and the man of sin shall be revealed, the son of perdition,
4 who opposes and exalts himself above
all that is called God,
or that is worshiped,
so that he sits as God in the temple of God,
setting himself forth,
that he is God.*

*2Th 2:3 No os engañe nadie en ninguna manera;
porque no vendrá sin que venga antes la apostasía,

Da 11:37 He will not regard the god of his fathers,
nor the desire of women,
nor regard any god.
For he shall magnify himself above all.

Da 11:37 Y del Dios de sus padres no se cuidará,
ni del amor de las mujeres:
ni se cuidará de dios alguno,
porque sobre todo se engrandecerá.

Ez 8:13 He also said to me, You turn again, and you shall see greater evils that they are doing

14 And He brought me to the opening of the gate of the LORD's house, toward the north. And behold, women were sitting there, weeping for Tammuz.

Ez 8:13 Díjome después: Vuélvete aún, verás abominaciones mayores que hacen éstos.

14 Y llevóme á la entrada de la puerta de la casa de Jehová, que está al aquilón; y he aquí mujeres que estaban allí sentadas endechando á Tammuz.

H6828 **north** צפון tsaw-fone' from 6845; properly, hidden, i.e. dark; used only of the north as a quarter (gloomy and unknown)

Gesenius' Hebrew-Chaldean Lexicon "...ancients regarded the north as obscure and dark"

Tammuz – Phoenician, Syrian Greek - Adonis

Hebrew root for Tammuz "tet, mem, zayin - tmz" = melt down

Da 11:38 But in his place he shall honor the god of forces; and a god whom his fathers did not know, he shall honor with gold and silver, and with precious stones and desirable things.

39 So he shall act in the fortresses of the strongholds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge. He shall multiply in glory, and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for a price.

Da 11:38 Mas honrará en su lugar al dios Mauzim, dios que sus padres no conocieron: honrarálo con oro, y plata, y piedras preciosas, y con cosas de gran precio.

39 Y con el dios ajeno que conocerá, hará á los baluartes de Mauzim crecer en gloria: y harálos enseñorear sobre muchos, y por interés repartirá la tierra.

Da 11:40 And at the end-time, the king of the south shall butt at him. And the king of the north shall come against him like a tempest, with chariots and with horsemen and with many ships.

41 And he shall enter into the countries and shall overflow and pass over. He shall also enter into the glorious land, and many shall be stumbled. But these shall escape out of his hand: Edom and Moab, and the chief of the sons of Ammon.

Da 11:40 Empero al cabo del tiempo el rey del mediodía se acorpeará con él; y el rey del norte levantará contra él como tempestad, con carros y gente de á caballo, y muchos navíos; y entrará por las tierras, é inundará, y pasará.

41 Y vendrá á la tierra deseable, y muchas provincias caerán; mas éstas escaparán de su mano: Edom, y Moab, y lo primero de los hijos de Ammón.

Da 11:42 And he shall stretch out his hand on the lands. And the land of Egypt shall not escape.

43 But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt. And the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps.

44 But news out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him. Then he will go out with great fury to destroy, and to devote many to destruction.

Da 11:42 Asimismo extenderá su mano á las otras tierras, y no escapará el país de Egipto.

43 Y se apoderará de los tesoros de oro y plata, y de todas las cosas preciosas de Egipto, de Libia, y Etiopía por donde pasará.

44 Mas nuevas de oriente y del norte lo espantarán; y saldrá con grande ira para destruir y matar muchos.

Da 11:45 And he shall plant his palace tents
between the seas in the glorious holy mountain.

Yet he shall come to his end,
and none shall help him.
