Hos 12:5 even יהוה Elohim of hosts, יהוה
is His remembrance.

remembrance – zeker = to be remembered (by/as) -*never to be forgotten, memorialized-*

nor My praise to idols.

Exo 3:15 And Elohim said further to Mosheh,
