
2. The Flood – sons of God & daughters of men

1Sa 17:1 And the Philistines had gathered their armies for battle, and came together at Sokoh, which belongs to Yehudah, and encamped between Sokoh and Azěqah, in Ephes Dammim. 2 And Sha'ul and the men of Yisra'ěl were gathered and encamped in the Valley of Ělah, and drew up in battle array to meet the Philistines. 3 And the Philistines stood on a mountain on one side, and Yisra'ěl stood on a mountain on the other side, with the valley between them.

From the Canaanites to the Philistines

1Sa 17:2 And Sha'ul and the men of Yisra'ěl were gathered and encamped in the Valley of Ělah, and drew up in battle array to meet the Philistines. 3 And the Philistines stood on a mountain on one side, and Yisra'ěl stood on a mountain on the other side, with the valley between them. 4 Then a champion came out from the camp of the Philistines, named Golyath, from Gath, whose height was six cubits and a span. (9-10 ft.)



1Sa 17:26 And Dawid spoke to the men who stood by him, saying, "What shall be done for the man who strikes this Philistine and shall take away reproach from Yisra'ěl? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should reproach the <u>armies</u> of the living Elohim?" 1Sa 17:45 But Dawid said to the Philistine, "You come to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a javelin. of hosts, יהוה But I come to you in the Name of יהוה of hosts, the Elohim of the armies of Yisra'ěl, whom you have reproached.



1Sa 17:5 And a bronze helmet was on his head, and he was armed with a scaled armour, and the weight of the coat was five thousand sheqels of bronze, (156 lbs.) 6 and bronze shin guards on his legs and a bronze spear between his shoulders. 7 And the wood of his spear was like a weaver's beam, and his iron spearhead weighed six hundred sheqels, (25 lbs) and a shield-bearer went before him.



1Sa 17:40 And he took his staff in his hand, and chose for himself <u>five smooth stones</u> from the wadi, and put them in a shepherd's bag, in a pouch which he had, and his sling was in his hand. And he drew near to the Philistine.

2Sa 21:16 And Ishbi penob, who was of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear was three hundred shekels of bronze in weight.

And he being girded with a new sword thought to kill David. 17 But Abishai the son of Zeruiah came to his aid, and struck the Philistine, and killed him. Then the men of David swore to him, saying, You shall not go out to battle with us anymore, so that you do not put out the light of Israel. 18 And it happened after this there was again a battle with the Philistines at Gob. Then Sibbechai the Hushathite killed Sa<mark>2</mark>h, who was of the sons of the giant. 19 And there was again a battle with the Philistines in Gob, where Elhanan of Bethlehem, the son of Jaare-oregim, killed one of Goliath ³e Gittite, the staff of whose spear was like a weaver's beam. 20 And there was yet again a battle in Gath. And there was a man o<mark>4</mark> tature who had six fingers on each hand, and six toes on each foot, twenty-four in number. And he also was born to the giant. 21 And when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimeah, the brother of David, killed him. 22 These four were born to the giant in Gath, and fell by the hand of David, and by the hand of his servants. (1Chr 20)



1Ch 14:9 And the Philistines came and made a raid on the Valley of Repha'im. 10 And Dawid inquired of Elohim, saying, "Do I go up against the Philistines? And shall You give them into my hand?" And יהוה said to him, "Go up, and I shall give them into your hand." 11 And they went up to Ba'al Peratsim, and Dawid struck them there. Then Dawid said, "Elohim has broken through my enemies by my hand like a breakthrough of water." So they called the name of that place Ba'al Peratsim.

(the breaking of Baal)



1Sa 17:54 And Dawid took the head of the Philistine and <u>brought it to Yerushalayim</u>, but he put his weapons in his tent.
