

- Ge 1-11 are global in scope (Table of Nations ch. 10)
- Ge 12 Rev 21 are the God of Israel and His people in conflict with the gods of the nations and their people
- Ge 12 the "Abrahamic Covenant" clarifies this, it will be Abraham's descendants and all of the families of the earth through faith in God's promise in conflict with those who are not
 - The land of promise will become the focus of all conflict because it belongs to the God of Israel and His people, where He will put "His name"
- The next 400 years will see squatters take the land of promise and serve their gods with their pagan practices, they are called the Canaanites
- Yah would use Egypt and their gods during that 400 years to prepare His people and their entrance into the land of promise now under control of the Canaanites
- Yah reveals that He alone is God by demonstrating His authority over the gods of Egypt in 10 distinct judgments "the 10 plagues" The final judgement would be on the "god of life", Pharoh himself and the first born of his kingdom
- Yah Himself would lead His people out (Shekinah) from under the authority of the gods of Egypt. This is called the "Exodus"

- Yah, the God of Israel is "set apart" from the gods of the nations
- The God of Israel, unlike these gods will be amongst, His people this is the purpose of the "Tabernacle and the High Priest"
- At a mountain in the wilderness, Sinai (Mt Choreb) He would set His people apart
- He would give them His Torah (instructions/law)
 - 1-4 detail their relationship with their God in respect to their interaction with the nations and their gods
 - #1 no gods before Him
 - #2 no images of those gods of heaven, earth or under the earth
 - #3 remember that their God is creator and that His work has ceased (Sabbath)
 - #4 do not carry Yah's name with emptiness by equating His name with the names of any other god
 - Ep 6:12b the real battle is against the wickedness in the heavenlies even today
- The Sacrificial system points to the One Who would restore His people back into relationship with Him
- Moedim which reveal the cycle of God's timing throughout history (His-Story)

Yom Kippur is unique


It is the only "appointed time" where Yah's people do not come to Him

It is the only day where Yah's people have no role or responsibility

It is the only day of the year that the high priest could enter Yah's presence

Atonement can be made only by the High Priest; the one receiving atonement is completely dependent on the atoning work of the High Priest In Lv.16 there are 80 verbs that describe the work of the High Priest alone, to make atonement

The one receiving atonement simply must cease from any effort and believe by faith in Yah's provision

Yeshuah begins His ministry in the 7th month (Tishri)

in the 6th month (Elul) Yeshuah is lead by the Spirit to the wilderness where He prays intensely and is preparing for His ministry as He is tested by the adversary for 40 days and "offered all the kingdoms of the earth" Mt 4:8

the 40th day He returns from the wilderness and takes His "Mikveh", baptism at Jordan with John the Baptist

that would be the 10th day of the 7th month "(Yom Kippur), or the "Day of Atonement"

He 7:24 But He, because He continues forever, has an unchangeable priesthood.

25 Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them.

26 For such a High Priest was fitting for us, Who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;
