

Most of the 70 nations listed in Genesis 10 can be traced NOLE to people groups living today. It is interesting that the names Japheth are Hebrew, and usually mean something even in the Modern Hebrew Language. Many of today's people groups still call them elves something similar to what God calls them in the Hebrew Bible! This provides one of the strong evidences that Magog Hebrew was the first language. 





Da 8:5 As I was considering, behold, a male goat came from the west over the surface of the whole eretz, and didn't touch the ground: and the goat had a notable horn between his eyes. 6 He came to the ram that had the two horns, which I saw standing before the river, and ran on him in the fury of his power.

The "Historical" Shadow

Da 8:20 The ram which you saw, that had the two horns, they are the kings of Madai and Paras. 21 The rough male goat is the king of Yavan: and the great horn that is between his eyes is the first king.

Yavan – Greece = Greek Empire "Alexander the Great"

Madai – Medes = *Kurdistan* Paras – Persians = Iran

Mikha'el, one of the chief princes,


came to help me: and I remained there with the kings of Paras.
