





PaRDeS

• Peshat ("plain"): The literal meaning of the text.

- Remez ("hint"): Does the literal meaning point to or hint at another passage in the bible?
- Drash ("seek"): What is the comparative meaning of the "peshat" and the "remez"?
- Sod ("mystery"): Meaning that is revealed only by God.

Mark 4:37-38:

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And a great windstorm arose, and the waves were breaking into the boat, so that the boat was already filling. But he was in the stern, asleep on the cushion. And they woke him and said to him, "Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?

Jonah 1:4-6:

But the LORD hurled a great wind upon the sea, and there was a mighty tempest on the sea, so that the ship threatened to break up. Then the mariners were afraid, and each cried out to his god. And they hurled the cargo that was in the ship into the sea to lighten it for them. But Jonah had gone down into the inner part of the ship and had lain down and was fast asleep. For he commanded and raised the stormy wind, which lifted the waves of the sea. They mounted up to heaven; they went down to the depths; their courage melted away in their evil plight; they reeled and staggered like drunken men and were at their wits' end.

Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress. He made the storm be still, and the waves of the sea were hushed. Then they were glad that the waters were quiet, and he brought them to their desired haven.
