

Yeshuah in Zechariah

“Yah Remembers”

Zec 7:1 And in the fourth year of King Darius, the Word of Jehovah was to Zechariah, in the fourth of the ninth month, in Chislev. (*Chislev - Nov/Dec*)

2 And Sharezer and Regem-melech, and his men, had sent to Bethel to seek the favor of the face of Jehovah, (*House of God*) = *Jerusalem not the Bethel of Jacob's dream*

3 to speak to the priests who *belong* to the house of Jehovah of Hosts, and to the prophets, saying,

Should I weep in the fifth month,

(Av – *Jul/Aug*)

consecrating myself as I have done these many years? (*LITV*)

The 4th month of “Av”, specifically the 9th day, is a day of mourning for the Jew’s to this day

Tishah B Av (*9th of Av*)
Remembering the Loss of Zion

Av = Father

Many major tragedies in the history of Israel have occurred on the particular day

For this reason, it has become an annual time of remembrance and mourning for the Jews

It occurs during our mid-July to mid-September

Yah decrees that the unfaithful generation at Canaan would wander 40yrs in wilderness till they died

The destruction of Solomon's (*first*) Temple by the Babylonians (*BC586*)

- *on the 17th of Tammuz, three weeks before Tishah B Av remembers Babylon's 1st breach of Jerusalem's walls*

The destruction of Herod's (*second*) Temple by the Romans (*30 Aug, 70AD*)

Roman Emperor Hadrian kills off the "Bar Koch bah" revolt at Beitar (*135AD*)

- *Names Judea "Palestine" and Jerusalem "Aelia Capitolina" forbidding Jews to enter Temple mount*
- *Rome's 10th Legion of the Strait (Legio X Fretensis) set up on the ruins of the Temple mount*

The Jews are expelled from England (*1290AD*)

The Jews are expelled from Spain (*1492AD*)

Zec 7:4 The Word of Jehovah of Hosts was to me, saying,

5 Speak to all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When you fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh *months*, even those seventy years, did you truly fast to Me, even to Me?

6 And when you ate, and when you drank, was it not for those eating, and for those drinking?

7 Are not *these* the Words which Jehovah proclaimed by the former prophets, when Jerusalem was inhabited, and prosperous with her cities all around her, and the Negeb and the Shephelah were inhabited?

(Negev = south - wilderness)

(Shephelah = lowlands - plains of Jericho)

Zec 7:8 And the Word of Jehovah was to Zechariah, saying,

9 So says Jehovah of Hosts, saying, Judge true judgment, and practice kindness and pity, *each* man with his brother.

10 And do not oppress the widow, or the fatherless, the alien, or the poor. And do not devise evil in your heart, of a man *against* his brother.

11 But they refused to listen, and gave a stubborn shoulder, and they made their ears heavy from hearing.

Zec 7:12 And they made their heart adamant from hearing the Law and the Words which Jehovah of Hosts has sent by the former prophets through His Spirit. And great wrath was from Jehovah of Hosts.

13 And it will be, just as He called, and they did not listen; so they called, and I did not listen, says Jehovah of Hosts.

14 But I stormed them away on all the nations whom they did not know. And the land is desolated behind them, from passing and from returning; for they made the land of desire a waste.

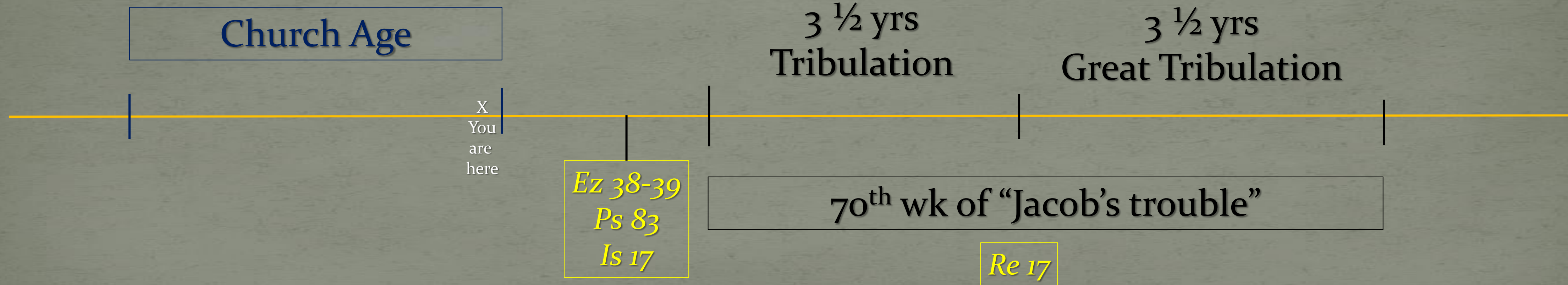

Re 17:1 And one of the seven angels who had the seven vials came and talked with me, saying to me, Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot sitting on many waters,

2 with whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and became drunk with the wine of her fornication, those inhabiting the earth.

3 And he carried me away into a desert by *the* Spirit. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet-colored beast, filled with names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet. And she was gilded with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication.

5 And on her forehead *was* a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

Re 17:6 And I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, I marveled with a great marveling.

7 And the angel said to me, Why did you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman and of the beast that carries her, that has the seven heads and ten horns.

8 The beast that you saw was, and is not, and is about to ascend out of the abyss and go into perdition. And those dwelling on the earth will marvel, those whose names were not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

Re 17:9 *And here is the mind which has wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sits.*

10 *And there are seven kings; five have fallen, and one is, and the other has not yet come. And when he comes, he must continue a short time.*

11 *And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition.*

12 *And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, who have received no kingdom yet, but will receive authority as kings one hour with the beast.*

13 *These have one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast.*

Re 17:14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them. For He is Lord of lords and King of kings. And those with Him *are* the called and elect and faithful ones.

15 And he says to me, The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues,

16 and the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot and will make her desolate and naked. And they will eat her flesh and burn her with fire.

17 For God gave into their hearts to do His mind, and to act with one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast until the Words of God will be fulfilled.

18 And the woman whom you saw is the great city which has a kingdom over the kings of the earth.

The extremist Islamist group came to international prominence in 2014 when it seized large parts of Syria and Iraq.

IS imposed its brutal rule on almost eight million people, carried out countless atrocities, destroyed cultural heritage, and generated billions of dollars in revenue from oil, extortion, robbery and kidnapping.

IS wants a "caliphate" - a state governed in accordance with Islamic law, or Sharia, by God's deputy on Earth (caliph) - that extends across the Islamic world.

The group justifies its attacks on Muslims and non-Muslims alike by drawing on extreme interpretations of Islamic texts.

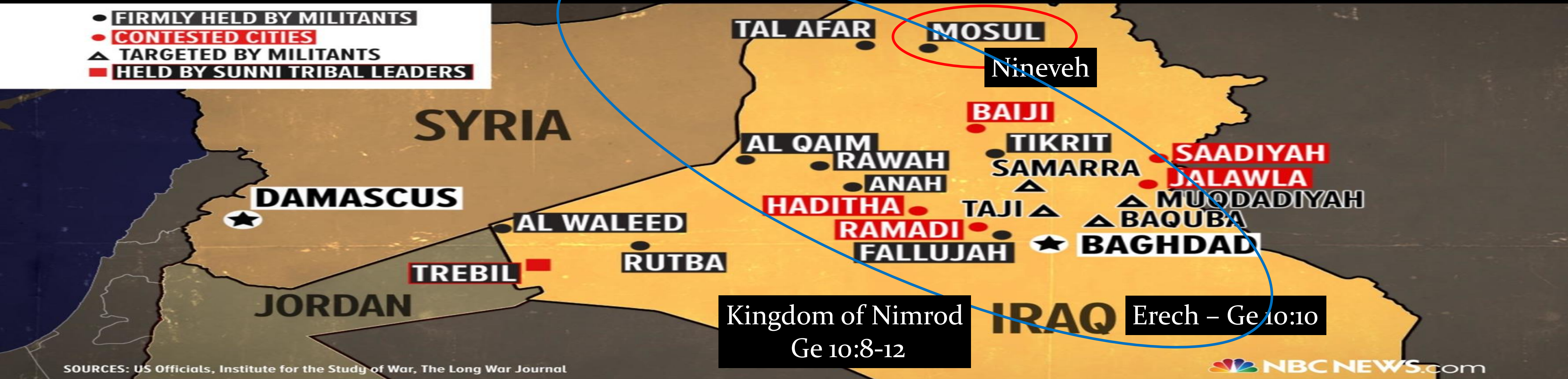

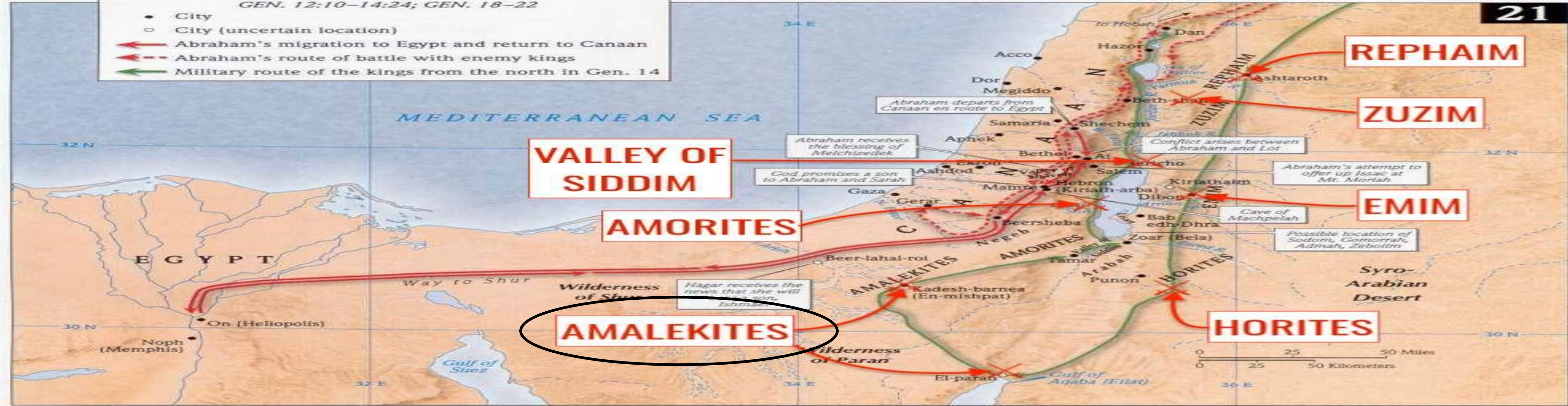
