**Zec 9:1** The burden of the Word of Jehovah against the land of Hadrach,  
and its resting-place,  
Damascus

(when the eye of man, and all the tribes of Israel, *shall be* toward Jehovah);

*burden – H2317 ma sa = load, carrying, weight, heaviness*

*Hadrach - H02317 khad-rawk' of uncertain derivation; Chadrak, a Syrian deity:--Hadrach.*

*chad = hard, sharp      rach = soft, tender*



**In the land of Hadrach:** R' Judah the son of Ilai expounded: **This is the Messiah, who is sharp against the nations and soft to Israel.** R' Yose the son of a Damascene mother said to him [to Judah the son of Ilai]: “Judah, our master, how long will you pervert the verses for us? I call heaven and earth to testify for me, that I am from Damascus, and there is a place named Hadrach. [Rabbi Yose continued:] Now how do I explain: 'And Damascus is His resting place?'” That Jerusalem is destined to reach as far as Damascus. ‘His resting place’ means only Jerusalem, as it is said: ([Psalms 132:14](#)) “This is My resting place to eternity.” He said to him [i.e. R' Judah to R' Yose]: “Now how do I explain ([Jer. 30:18](#)) 'And the city shall be built on its mound?'” He replied: “That it is not destined to move from its place.” So was the baraita taught in Sifre ([Deut. 1:1](#)).

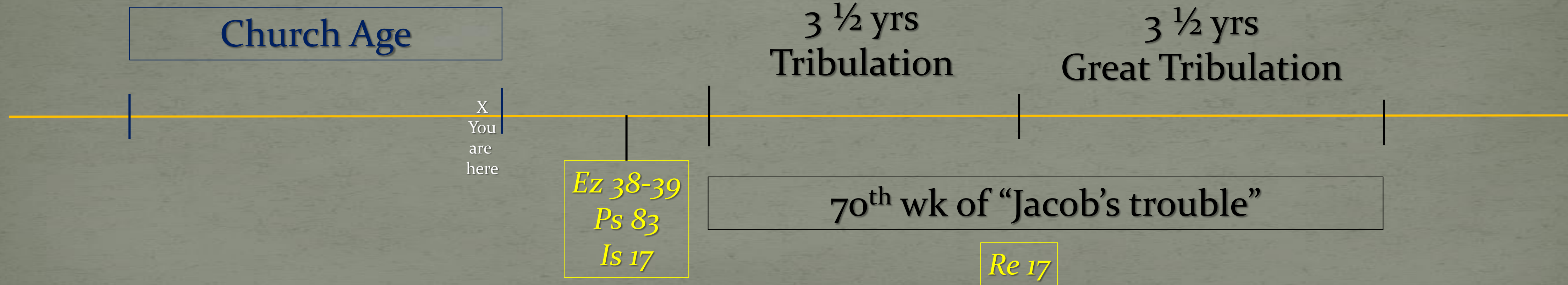

Re 17:1 And one of the seven angels who had the seven vials came and talked with me, saying to me, Come here, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot sitting on many waters,

2 with whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and became drunk with the wine of her fornication, those inhabiting the earth.

3 And he carried me away into a desert by *the* Spirit. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet-colored beast, filled with names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

4 And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet. And she was gilded with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication.

Re 17:14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them. For He is Lord of lords and King of kings. And those with Him *are* the called and elect and faithful ones.

15 And he says to me, The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits are peoples and multitudes and nations and tongues,

16 and the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot and will make her desolate and naked. And they will eat her flesh and burn her with fire.

17 For God gave into their hearts to do His mind, and to act with one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast until the Words of God will be fulfilled.

# The rise and fall of the Islamic State group: The long and short story

The extremist Islamist group came to international prominence in 2014 when it seized large parts of Syria and Iraq.

IS imposed its brutal rule on almost eight million people, carried out countless atrocities, destroyed cultural heritage, and generated billions of dollars in revenue from oil, extortion, robbery and kidnapping.

IS wants a "caliphate" - a state governed in accordance with Islamic law, or Sharia, by God's deputy on Earth (caliph) - that extends across the Islamic world.

The group justifies its attacks on Muslims and non-Muslims alike by drawing on extreme interpretations of Islamic texts.

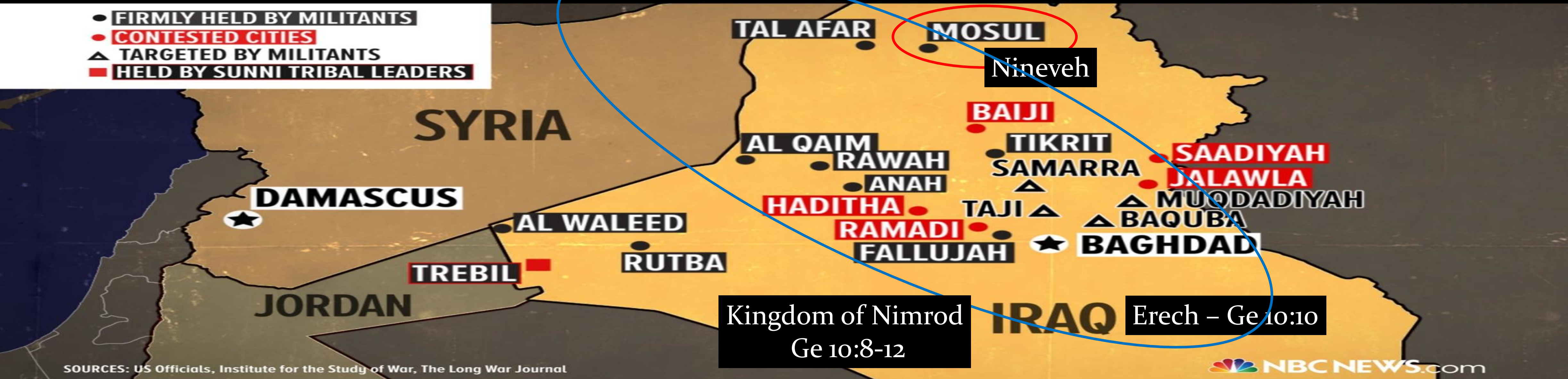

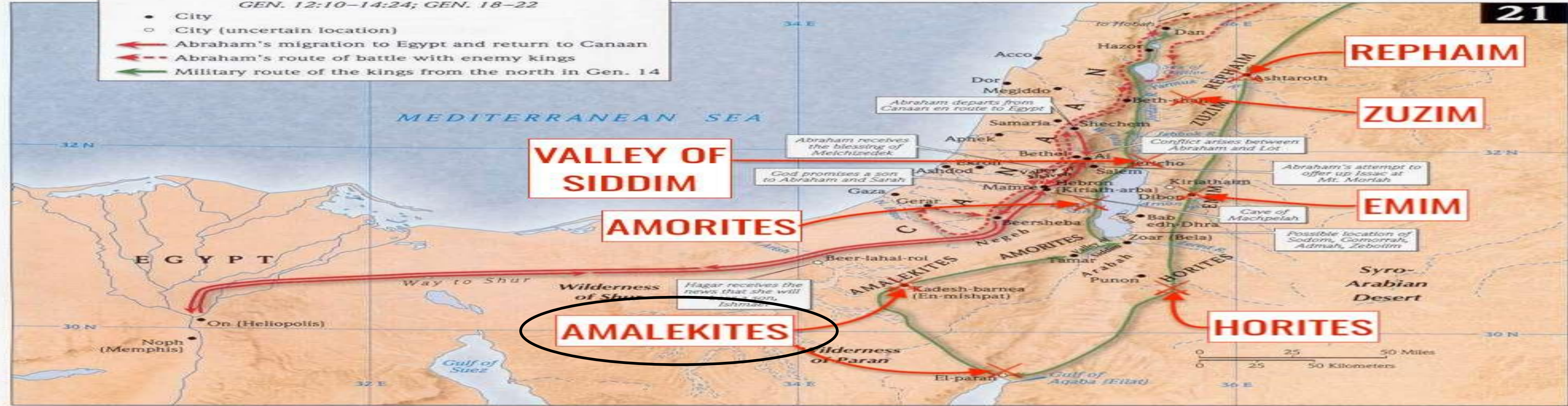
