Scripture and the Supernatural

Heaven is the Creator's "throne" room in the spiritual/divine realm

He administers His authority in heaven through the "divine counsel"

Eden is the Creators "foot stool" in the physical/earthly realm

He administers His authority on the earth through man (Adam) a member of His earthly realm, in coordination with a representative(s) of the "divine counsel"

Eden is the place where heaven and earth intersect, each under the authority of the Creator (Is 66:1, Ac 7:49)

EARLY JUDAISM UNDERSTOOD EDEN AS A TEMPLE


- There are many similarities between Eden and the subsequent temples.
- It is important to know how early Judaism viewed the Garden of Eden.
- Beale suggests, "early Judaism understood the Garden to be the first sanctuary..."
- For example, the Jewish interpretation of the book of Jubilees (160 B.C.) shows that early Judaism considered Eden as a temple.
- Perhaps the most explicit mention of Eden as being a temple is Jubilees 8:19, which says: "And he [Noah] knew that the Garden of Eden was the holy of holies, and the dwelling of the Lord." Thus, the early Jewish writings confirm the notion of Eden being a temple as a reasonable conclusion.

Jubilees 8:19 And he (Noah) knew that the Garden of Eden is the kodesh of kodeshim, and the dwelling of YAHWEH, (holy of holies) and Mount Sinai the center of the desert, and Mount Zion -the center of the navel of the earth: these three were created as kodesh places facing each other. 20 And he blessed the ALMIGHTY of gods, who had put the Word of YAHWEH into his mouth, and YAHWEH forevermore.




