Gen 1:27 So God created

Gen 1:27 So Elohiym created  
man in His own image,  
in the image of **Elohiym**  
created He him;  
male and female  
created He them.

*Let us make man.* From here we learn the humility of the Holy One, blessed be He.

*Since man was created in the likeness of the angels, and they would envy him, He consulted them. And when He judges kings, He consults with His Heavenly household, for so we find regarding Ahab, that Micah said to him, ([I Kings 22:19](#)): “I saw the Lord seated on His throne, and all the host of heaven were standing by Him, on His right and on His left.” Now do “left” or “right” apply to Him ?! But rather, [the passage means that] these [angels] were standing on the right to defend, and these [angels] were standing on the left to prosecute.*

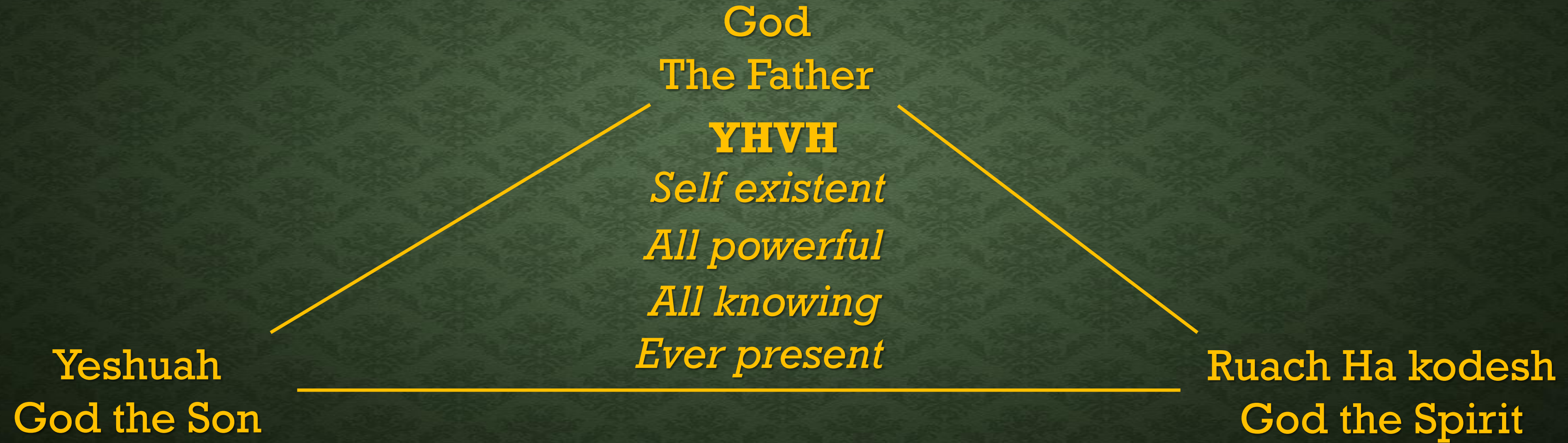
**Rashi from Tanchuma, Shemoth 18; Gen. Rabbah 8:11, 14:13**

*...Had it been written: “I shall make man,” we would not have learned that He was speaking with His tribunal, but to Himself. And the refutation to the heretics is written alongside it* **(Trinitarians)**

15 So he came to the king. And the king said to him, Micaiah, Shall we go against Ramoth in Gilead to battle, or shall we hold off? And he answered him, Go and prosper. For Jehovah shall deliver *it* into the hand of the king.



1Ki 22:16 And the king said to him, how many times shall I adjure you that you tell me nothing but *what is* true, in the name of Jehovah?

17 And he said, I saw all Israel scattered on the hills, like sheep that have no shepherd. And Jehovah said, These have no master. Let each man return to his house in peace.

Rabis – those on the right are the just  
those on the left are the unjust



1Ki 22:22 And Jehovah said to him, With what? And he said, I will go forth and will be a lying spirit in the mouth of all his prophets. And He said, You shall entice *him* and succeed also. Go forth and do so.

23 And now, behold, Jehovah has put a lying spirit in the mouth of all these your prophets, and Jehovah has spoken evil concerning you.

1Ki 22:24 But Zedekiah the son of Chenaanah went near and struck Micaiah on the cheek, and said, Which way did the Spirit of Jehovah go from me to speak to you?
