Multiple "flood" versions

There are flood accounts in every culture that has existed throughout human history

Mesopotamian accounts (Sumerian, Accadian and Babylonian)

The most known account is the "Epic of Gilgamesh" and the "Enuma Elish"

The story of the Anunnaki and the Apkallu

Ea the god of the Abzu The "Abyss", the primordial sea Ea, creator of the Apkallu as his emissaries from the "Abzu" He fashioned them as part human, fish and man Apkallu, seven sages brough givers of wisdom of the deep, called "Metsery" Metsery = watcher Oranes is most known - Berosus

Divine beings who served between the gods (Annunaki) and humanity as teachers, guides and protectors

Scally beings who brought knowledge of astrology, magic, agriculture, warfare, cosmetics, genetics and medicine

As humanities guides, the Apkallu develop a sensitivity for them

The Anunnaki become frustrated with humanity who keep waking them with being to noisy

The decision is made to destroy humanity by drowning them with a flood

The Apkallu warn a specific human, Utnapishtim, to build a boat so humanity can survive the flood

The Anunnaki are angered by this treachery,

so, they condemn the Apkallu to an eternity in the Abzu from which they came
After the flood their wisdom is passed on to 7 kings who are also referred to as "Apkallu"
These Apkallu are demigods, part human, part divine

The one we know most about is "Gilgamesh", he is called 2/3 god and 1/3 human
