#1-Genesis 1:1

Gen 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth;

Gen 1:1 In the beginning Elohim created the heavens and the earth.

(TS2009)

God – Elohim "the CREATOR"

The KJV translates Strong's H430 (Elohim) in the following manner

God (2,346x), god (244x), judge (5x), GOD (1x), goddess (2x), great (2x), mighty (2x), angels (1x), exceeding (1x), God-ward (with H4136) (1x), godly (1x).

Blue Letter Bible; Ge 1:1 (tools)

The words Elohim or elohim are **NEVER** applied to anyone in the human realm

It is used exclusively for those of the divine realm

The word cannot be defined by attributes

The "Attributes of God" can apply to Yah alone!!!

It is Elohim's personal name, "Yah", that makes Him unique to all other divine beings

"The "Holy One, Blessed be He, said to those, you want to know My Name? I am called according to My actions. When I judge the creatures, I am Elohim, and when I have mercy with my world, I am named YHVH." (Ex R. 3:6)

El (213x)(32x)(total 245x)

El (sing) = powerful, strong, mighty

When used of the Creator it is qualified by descriptions that distinguish Him from all other gods

El echad = the One God

Mal 2:10 "Have we not all one Father? Did not one <u>Él create us</u>?"...

El hanne'eman = Faithful God

Deu 7:9 "And you shall know that יהוה your Elohim, He is Elohim, the trustworthy <u>Ěl</u>

El emet = God of truth

Psa 31:5 Into Your hand I commit my spirit; You have redeemed me, O יהוה $\underline{\text{El of truth}}$.

El tzaddik = God of righteousness

Is 45:21 ..."Is it not I, יהוה? And there is no mighty one besides Me, a righteous El and a Saviour, there is none besides Me."

El shaddai = the all sufficient (almighty)

Ge 17:1 ... "I am <u>Ěl Shaddai</u> – walk before Me and be perfect."

El elyon = God most high

Gen 14:19 And he blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram of the Most High El, Possessor of the heavens and earth.

"Eloah"

(57x; 41x in Job)

The singular form of Elohim

Eloah = the mighty existing, eternal One (no equal - unique)

Psa 18:31 For who is Eloah, besides יהוה? And who is a rock, except our Elohim?

Isa 44:8 Do not fear, nor be afraid. Have I not since made you hear, and declared it?

You are My witnesses.

Is there an Eloah besides Me?
There is no other Rock,
I know not one."
