agape – love =
unconditional

Phileo – love =
affection

Joh 21:15 Then when they broke fast, Jesus said to Simon Peter,
Simon, son of Jonah, do **agape** Me more than these?
He said to Him, Yes, Lord, You know that I **phileo** .
He said to him, Feed My lambs.
16 He said to him the second time,
Simon, son of Jonah, do **agape** Me?
He said to Him, Yes, Lord, You know that I **phileo** .
He said to him, Feed My sheep.

G3398 **least**- μικροτερος (mikroteros) = small (in size, quantity, number) less, little small <30x>

Seemingly insignificant, in position or title

1Co 15:9 For I am the least of the apostles and am not sufficient to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

G1646 **least** – ελαχιστος (elachistos) = used as an equivalent ,small in size, dignity <13x>

“last in sequence, last in line”

Joh 8:15 You judge after the flesh, I judge no one.

Joh 8:16 And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I and the Father who sent Me.

G2919 judge – κρινω (krino) = to determine, to decree, call in question <98x>
(to state a case)

G2920 judgment – κρισις (krisis) = accusation, condemnation, damnation
(to render a verdict)

*“if I were to bring state my case and bring accusation,
My verdict to condemn would be based on truth as witnessed by the Father*

(Rick’s translation)

V16 – “all Scripture”

G.1124. γραφή - graf-ay' = a document, i.e. holy Writ (or its contents or a statement in it)

What Scripture is Paul referring to?

(the whole “all” of the Old Testament)

God’s appointed “Moedim” times (they are His not Israel’s – Lv 23:2)

Passover

Un Bread

First Fruits

Pentecost

Christ died

Christ was buried

Christ rose again

Holy Spirit

1Co 15:1-4

“THE GOSPEL”

(Christ’s first coming to REDEEM)

Trumpets	Day of Atonement	Tabernacles
<i>Christ returns</i>	<i>Christ judges nations</i>	<i>Christ rules nations</i>

Mt 24:30-31 (Christ's second coming to RULE)

Are there other passages that refer to the whole Old Testament?

- Jn 5:39 "Scriptures...they which testify of Me"
 - Lk 24:27 "Moses and all the Prophets...in all the Scriptures concerning Himself"
 - Ac 8:35 "Philip beginning at this Scripture (Isaiah) preached Jesus unto him"
 - Ac 28:22-23 Paul persuaded them "concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets"
- Paul and the "Roman's road" and his letter to the Romans ("*the scripture*" 13x, "*it is written*" 36x)
