agape – love = unconditional Intentional sacrificial

Phileo – love = affection

G3398 least- μικροτεροσ (mikroteros) = small (in size, quantity, number) less, little small <30x>

Seemingly insignificant, in position or title

1Co 15:9 For I am the least of the apostles and am not sufficient to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

G1646 least – ελαχιστος (elachistos) = used as an equivalent ,small in size, dignity <13x>

"last in sequence, last in line"

Joh 8:15 You judge after the flesh, I judge no one.

Joh 8:16 And yet if I do judge, My judgment is true; for I am not alone, but I and the Father who sent Me.

G2919 judge – κρινω (krino) = to determine, to decree, call in question <98x> (to state a case)

G2920 judgment – κρισις (krisis) = accusation, condemnation, damnation (to render a verdict)

"if I were to bring state my case and bring accusation, My verdict to condemn would be based on truth as witnessed by the Father V16 – "all Scripture"

G.1124. $\gamma \rho \alpha \phi \eta$ - graf-ay' = a document, i.e. holy Writ (or its contents or a statement in it)
