The *Authorized* Texts

Jud 1:3 Having made all haste to write to you about the common salvation, beloved, I had need to write to you to exhort *you* to contend earnestly for the faith once delivered to the saints.

4 For certain men crept in secretly, those having been of old previously written into this condemnation, ungodly ones perverting the grace of our God for unbridled lust, and denying the only Master, God, even our Lord Jesus Christ.

5 But I intend to remind you, you once knowing these things, that the Lord having delivered a people out of the land of Egypt, in the second place destroyed the ones not believing.

6 And those angels not having kept their first place,
but having deserted their dwelling-place,
He has kept in everlasting chains under darkness
for the judgment of a great Day;

Jud 1:7 as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities around them, in like manner to these, committing fornication, and going away after other flesh, laid down an example before-times, undergoing vengeance of everlasting fire.

8 Likewise, indeed, also these dreaming ones even defile flesh, and despise rulership, and speak evil of glories.

9 But Michael, the archangel, when contending with the Devil, he argued about the body of Moses, he dared not bring a judgment of blasphemy, but said, Let the Lord rebuke you!

10 But what things they do not know, they speak evil of. And what things they understand naturally, like the animals without reason, they are corrupted by these.

11 Woe to them! For they went the way of Cain and gave themselves up to the error of Balaam for reward and perished in the gainsaying of Korah.

12 These are sunken rocks in your love feasts, feasting together with you; feeding themselves without fear; waterless clouds being carried about by winds; fruitless autumn trees, having died twice, having been plucked up by the roots;

13 wild waves of the sea foaming up their shames; wandering stars for whom blackness of darkness has been kept forever.

Jud 1:14 Now Enoch,
the seventh from Adam,
prophesied about these men also, saying,
"Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints,
15 "to execute judgment on all,
to convict all who are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds
which they have committed in an ungodly way,
and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."
16 These are murmurers, complainers,
leading lives according to their lusts.
And their mouth speaks proud things,
admiring faces for the sake of gain.

En 1:1 The words of the blessing of Enoch, wherewith he blessed the elect and righteous, who will be living in the days of tribulation, when all the wicked and godless are to be removed.

2 And Enoch, a righteous man whose eyes were opened by God took up his parable and said, "I saw the vision of the Holy One in the heavens, which the angels showed me, and from them I heard everything, and from them I understood as I saw, but not for this generation, but for a remote one which is for to come."

3 Concerning the elect I said, and took up my parable concerning them: "The Holy Great One will come forth from His dwelling,

4 And the eternal God will tread upon the earth, even on Mount Sinai and will appear in the strength of His might from the heaven of heavens.

5 And all shall be smitten with fear and the Watchers shall quake, and great fear and trembling shall seize them unto the ends of the earth

En 1:6 And the high mountains shall be shaken, and the high hills shall be made low and shall melt like wax before the flame.
7 And the earth shall be wholly rent in sunder and all that is upon the earth shall perish, and there shall be a judgement upon all.

8 But with the righteous He will make peace. And will protect the elect, And mercy shall be upon them. And they shall all belong to God, And they shall be prospered, And they shall all be blessed. And He will help them all, And light shall appear unto them, and He will make peace with them

*En 1:9 And behold! He cometh with ten thousands of His holy ones
to execute judgement upon all,
And to destroy all the ungodly:*

*And to convict all flesh Of all the works of their ungodliness which they have ungodly committed,
And of all the hard things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him."*

En 6.2 And the Angels, the sons of Heaven, saw them and desired them. And they said to one another: "Come, let us choose for ourselves wives, from the children of men, and let us beget, for ourselves, children."

3 And Semyaza, who was their leader, said to them: "I fear that you may not wish this deed to be done, and that I alone will pay for this great sin."

4 And they all answered him and said: "Let us all swear an oath, and bind one another with curses, so not to alter this plan, but to carry out this plan effectively."

5 Then, they all swore together, and all bound one another, with curses, to it.

6 And they were, in all, two hundred, and they came down on Ardis, which is the summit of Mount Hermon. And they called the mountain Hermon, because on it they swore, and bound one another with curses.

7 And these are the names of their leaders: Semyaza, who was their leader, Urakiba, Ramiel, Kokabiel, Tamiel, Ramiel, Daniel, Ezeqiel, Baraqiel, Asael, Armaros, Batriel, Ananel, Zaqiel, Samsiel, Sartael, Turiel, Yomiel, Araziel.

8 These are the leaders of the two hundred Angels, and of all the others with them.
