

Art Classes

February- Theme- Oceans

Understanding how to draw can build confidence for students. Even very young students can be taught to look at simple shapes and reproduce what they see. Students are given a story for inspiration. Then we learn the alphabet of drawing- the straight line, the curved line, the dashed line, the closed shaped and the filled in shape. These are practiced in abstract warm ups, and then applied to a simple line drawings, which can be colored. We finish up with a free form craft- such as a model, or a painting.

March- Theme- Famous Buildings

From the Golden Domes of Eastern Europe to Bridges in Venice and Lighthouses. We will tour the world and all manner of architecture.

April- Art through History

We will explore ancient cave paintings, frescos by Angelica, weather scenes by El Greco, and Impressionism by Van Gogh
