

Install LatchLid Plates and Tamper-Proof Screws

- 1. Remove the 2 factory tail light fasteners (see Figure 1).
- 2. Slide the LatchLid plate in place, around the striker.
- 3. Secure the LatchLid plate using a tamper-proof screw and stainless washer, placing a nylon spacer behind the plate, between the plate and the post. See Figure 2.
- 4. Tighten the tamper-proof screw sufficiently to loosely hold the LatchLid plate in place.
- 5. Adjust the position of the LatchLid plate, sliding it toward the front of the truck, and rotating it around the striker so the LatchLid plate is straight up and down.
- 6. Close the tailgate carefully. Inspect the LatchLid plate positioning and adjust as required. When properly positioned, LatchLid will not interfere with the tailgate opening/closing. If LatchLid is in contact with the tailgate, remove it and bend it slightly, opening up the 90 degree "L" bend a couple degrees. Then re-test.
- 7. Install a tamper-proof screw and stainless washer in the lower tail light fastener hole. Tighten the tamper-proof screws. Do not overtighten. Figure 3 shows the LatchLid installed.
- 8. Repeat steps 1-7 for the other side of the truck.

Install Fastener to Block Access to Internal Tailgate Release

- 9. Remove 8 fasteners to remove the access plate on the bed side of the tailgate (see Figure 4).
- 10. Insert and fasten bolt, washers, and lock nut into the internal access hole (see Figures 5 and 6). The bolt does not have to be centered in the hole.
- 11. Reinstall the access plate and the 8 fasteners.



