Court Victories

Facility Inspection Tracker

Inspection reports from multiple federal facilities highlight continued concerns regarding staffing shortages, medical service delays, and program accessibility. Oversight and transparency remain key issues across the federal prison system.

Inmate Rights Alerts

Incarcerated individuals maintain constitutional protections including access to courts, medical treatment, religious freedom, and protection from cruel and unusual punishment. Documenting grievances remains a critical step when rights violations occur.
