CONTENT WARNINGS

9 to 5 deals with, and contains, several aspects we would like to give audience members a warning of. These Include:

- Frequent changes in lighting effects and bright lights.
- Frequent, and occasionally sudden, loud music played by a live band in the theatre, and sung by the performers with microphones.
- Occasional shouting
- References to alcohol & marijuana use
- Negative comments towards characters with substance use disorder
- Reference to and depiction of a non-realistic deceased body
- Use of a fake gun and sudden sound effects of gunshots
- Depiction of a character being restrained
- Threats of Violence
