Director's Message

Floyd Collins is a tale, a story. It has been told in various ways in the Southern states of the United States since 1925 and it continues to be a reality for the small town of Cave City. Adam Guettel and Tina Landau have chosen to tell it through music. The compelling tale of Floyd Collins is enriched by both the moving text and inspirational music.

I was recently asked why this story was a musical; why not a play. I think it is because Tina Landau (book/additional lyrics) and Adam Guettel (music/lyrics) realized that this story needed to be told through the music of the culture and time. What results is unique and one of the most interesting musical theatre shows I have ever encountered.

Floyd Collins is based on a true story which takes place in Cave City, Kentucky during February 1925. The characters are all based on real people and the events are, for the most part, historically accurate. Adam Guettel and Tina Landau stumbled across this unusual story, were intrigued by it, and decided to workshop a script and score and in 1996 the show premiered Off-Broadway.

I hope as an audience this piece challenges your ideas of what musical theatre is. The music is not always pleasant, however, it is intricate and compelling. The text is difficult to understand at times because of the dialect, yet is full of emotion and character. These challenges are what attracted me to this piece and have excited me throughout this entire process. I hope that they do the same for you.

This musical is full of themes, messages, lessons - all the things that a director craves. In exploring all the "meat" of this script, I have continued to come back to the simplicity of this story: the two brothers. I think that this show is about the relationship between siblings, especially Floyd and Homer. In the midst of this media whirlwind, Homer continued to reach for Floyd as he slipped away from him. It is through Homer's eyes that I have come to understand this story.

There are an infinite number of people that I have to thank for making this production a reality; my heart is full of gratitude. Thank you for coming to see this piece and I hope that you can leave with your own understanding of this story. Enjoy.
